

**STATEMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH
SUBSECTION 189 (1) OF THE ACT**

The Police Federation of Australia, New South Wales Branch, hereby gives notice as follows:

- (a) In accordance with rule 52EH(g)(b) elections are required for the positions of Ordinary Members of the Branch Executive for the Endeavour, Western and Non Local Area Command regions.
- (b) The elections are required, as the incumbents have been elected to positions of Branch President, Branch Vice President and Branch Treasurer. On 23 May 2004 the Australian Electoral Commission declared the election of these positions. I have attached a copy of the declaration (marked A) along with a copy of the declarations previously made on March 23 and 13 April 2004 regarding the elections of Ordinary Executive members (marked B and C respectively)
- (c) Members in each region elect ordinary Branch Executive members on a proportionate basis of for up to the first one thousand (1,000) members, then one for each and every additional one thousand (1,000) members in each Region. Rule 52EG(e)(iii).
- (d) The electorate comprises only members of the Police Federation of Australia, New South Wales Police Branch.
