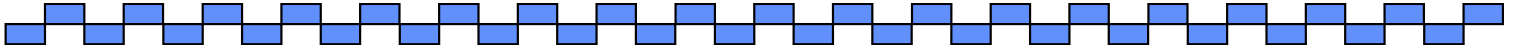
The Police Federation of Australia, New South Wales Police Branch, hereby gives notice as follows:
