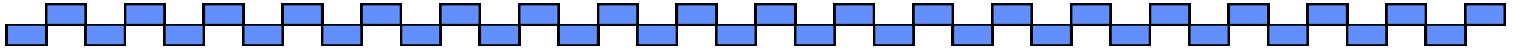



The Police Federation of Australia, New South Wales Police Branch, hereby gives notice as follows:

(a) In accordance with rule 52EH (G) an election is required for the position of Ordinary Branch Executive Member for the South West Metropolitan Region Area 1.

(b) An election is required for the position Ordinary Branch Executive Member for the South West Metropolitan Region Area 1, as the incumbent, Mr Trent Atkins has resigned from the position in a letter dated 2 December 2010 effective on 6 December 2010.
