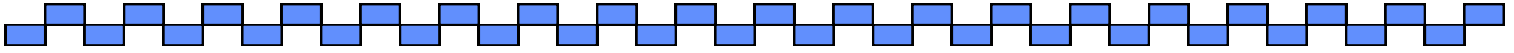

SUBSECTION 189 (1) OF THE ACT**

The Police Federation of Australia, New South Wales Police Branch, hereby gives notice as follows:

(a) In accordance with rule 52EH (G) an election is required for the position of Ordinary Branch Executive Member for the Central Metropolitan Region Area One.
