- a) In accordance with rule 52ER an election is required for a position of delegate to Federal Council.
- b) The election is required as an incumbent delegate, Tony Bear, has resigned his position as an Ordinary Branch Executive member effective 14 November 2012. In accordance with rules 52 EO and 52 ER con no longer hold the office of Federal Council Delegate. A copy of his resignation letter is attached and marked A.
- c) Police Federation of Australia rule 52EQ states that "Delegates to Federal Council representing the NSW Police Branch shall be the Branch President, the Branch Vice President and the Branch Treasurer. - i) The voting system is a collegiate system and the rules are silent on the date that the roll of voters should close prior to an election be conducted for a Delegate to Federal Council.


