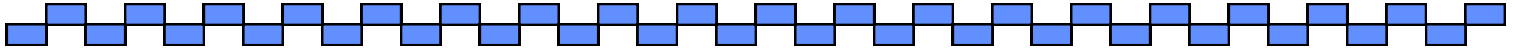

***STATEMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH
SUBSECTION 189 (1) OF THE ACT***

The Police Federation of Australia, New South Wales Branch, hereby gives notice as follows:

I. Election of Delegates to Branch Biennial Conference

- (a) In accordance with rule 52EG (a)(iii) elections are required for the positions of delegate to Branch Biennial Conference.
- (b) The elections are required, as the terms of office for delegates will expire on 18 April 2014.
- (c) All members in each region elect conference delegates on a proportional basis of one per 100 or part thereof members in each region. Rule 52EG (e)(iii)(a).
- (d) Annexure A details the number of members in each of the electoral regions as of 10 December 2013
- (e) Pursuant to rule 52EG (e)(iii)(a) the number of positions of conference delegates that are to be elected in each region is detailed in Annexure A.
- (f) The electorate comprises only financial members of the respective Region (as set out in Annexure A) Police Federation of Australia, New South Wales Police Branch.
- (g) The elections shall commence on the first Monday in February in 2014. Rule 52EG (e)(ii).
- (h) The electoral roll of members will close seven (7) days before the calling of nominations. Rule 52EG(e)(i)(a).
- (i) The returning officer shall determine the beginning and the end of the nomination period.
- (j) The kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election is a direct voting System. Rule 52EG(e)(iii).

II. Election of Ordinary Members of Branch Executive

- (a) Rule 52EG(a)(ii) requires that elections be held for positions of ordinary Branch Executive members.
- (b) The elections are required, as the terms of office for ordinary Executive members will expire at the completion of the Branch Biennial Conference on 15 May 2014.
- (c) Members in each region elect ordinary Branch Executive members on a proportionate basis of one for up to the first one thousand (1,000) members, then one for each and every additional one thousand (1,000) members in each Region. Rule 52EG(e)(iii)(b).
- (d) Annexure A details the number of members in each of the electoral regions as of 10 December 2013.
- (e) Pursuant to rule 52EG(e)(iii)(b) the number of positions of Ordinary Executive Members that are to be elected in each region is detailed in Annexure A.
- (f) The electorate comprises only financial members of the respective Region (see Annexure A) Police Federation of Australia, New South Wales Police Branch.
- (g) The elections shall commence on the first Monday in February in 2014. Rule 52EG(e)(ii).
- (h) The electoral roll of members will close seven (7) days before the calling of nominations. Rule 52EG(e)(i)(a).
- (i) The returning officer shall determine the beginning and the end of the nomination period.
- (j) The kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election is a direct voting System. Rule 52EG(e)(iii)

III. Election of Officers of the Branch

- (a) In accordance with rule 52EH (a) elections are required for the positions of President, Vice President and Treasurer.
- (b) The election is required, as the terms of office for these positions will expire on 12 May 2014.
- (c) Delegates to the Branch Biennial Conference elect, by secret ballot, the positions of President, Vice President and Treasurer.
- (d) The electorate comprises only delegates to the Biennial Conference of the New South Wales Police Branch of the Police Federation of Australia. Rules 52EH(c)(i)
- (e) The elections will commence at 4:00pm on 12 May 2014. Rule 52EH(b)
- (f) The returning officer shall determine the beginning and the end of the nomination period.
- (g) The kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election is a collegiate voting system. Rules 52EH(c)(i)

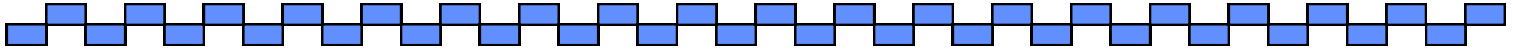
