Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 1 May 2014 the Police Federation of Australia - New South Wales Police Branch lodged with the Fair Work Commission the prescribed information in relation to an election for the following offices:

Delegates to Federal Council (5)

- [2] The prescribed information was not lodged before the day prescribed by Regulation 138(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009*. That day is the day occurring 2 months before the first day when a person may, under the rules of the organisation or branch, become a candidate in the election. The Branch has requested that I allow a later day for the lodgement of the prescribed information under subsection 189(2) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the Act). Having considered the reason for late lodgement, I allow lodgement on 1 May 2014 in this instance.
- [3] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

The Police Federation of Australia, New South Wales Police Branch, hereby gives notice as follows:
(a) In accordance with rule 52ER elections are required for positions of delegate to Federal Council.
(b) The election is required as the terms of office for delegates are due to expire on 12 May 2014
(c) Police Federation of Australia rule 52ER states that "The Delegates to Federal Council representing the NSW Police Branch shall be the Branch President, Branch Vice President and Branch Treasurer. The remaining delegate positions shall be elected by and from the Branch Executive in accordance with Rule 52EH, mutatis mutandis, as soon as possible after the declaration of the election of Branch Executive".
(d) Police Federation of Australia rule 14 (b) states that "The number of delegates in each Branch shall be determined on the basis of one delegate for the first one thousand (1,000) financial members or part thereof, and one additional delegate for each succeeding two thousand five hundred (2,500) financial members or part thereof".
(e) Police Federation of Australia rule 14 (d) states that "For the purposes of this Rule, the financial membership of the Federation and within each Branch shall be that membership as at 31 December in the immediately preceding year".

- (f) As of the 31 December 2013 the NSW Police Branch had 16,077 financial members. In accordance with Police Federation of Australia rule 14 (b) this would entitle the NSW Police branch to 8 delegates to the Federal Council.
- (g) On May 12th 2014 the Australian Electoral Commission is scheduled to conduct elections for the positions of President, Vice President and Treasurer. Accordingly an election for 5 positions of Delegate to Federal Council is required. A copy of the Notice for the Election from the Australian Electoral Commission is attached and marked A.
- (h) The electorate comprises only the members of the Executive of the Police Federation of Australia, New South Wales Police Branch. On 20 March 2014 and 17 April 2014 the Australian Electoral Commission declared the election of the positions of Ordinary Executive Members. Copies of these declarations are hereby attached and marked B and C respectively.
- (i) The voting system is a collegiate electoral system.
- (j) Nominations are requested to be opened and closed at the Branch Executive Meeting scheduled for 12 June 2014.
