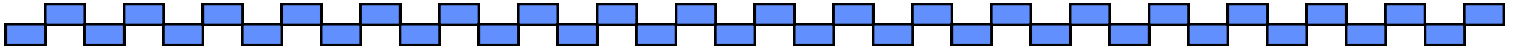

STATEMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH

SUBSECTION 189 (1) OF THE ACT

The Police Federation of Australia, New South Wales Police Branch, hereby gives notice as follows:

- a) In accordance with rule 52 EH (h) an election is required for a position of Ordinary Branch Executive Member Western Region. The period of office intended to be filled via the election is the remainder of the term of office.
- b) The election is required as the incumbent, Robert Dunn, has been promoted to Commissioned Officer Rank (rule 52 EH (h) (iv) (b) and has resigned his position as an Ordinary Branch Executive member effective 9 March 2015. A copy of his resignation letter is attached and marked A.
- c) The electorate comprises only financial members of the Western Region of the Police Federation of Australia, New South Wales Police Branch. Rule 52 EG (b) (i) (1).
- d) The electoral roll of members will close seven (7) days before the calling of nominations. Rule 52EG (e) (i) (a).
- e) The returning officer shall determine the dates for the opening and closing of nominations and the opening and closing of the ballot. Rule 52 EH (h) (ii).
- f) The kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election is a direct voting System. Rule 52 EG (e) (iii).
