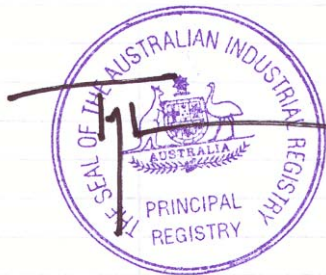
DECISION

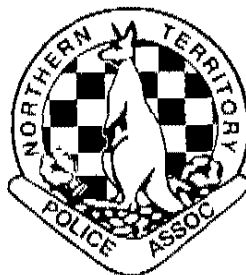
