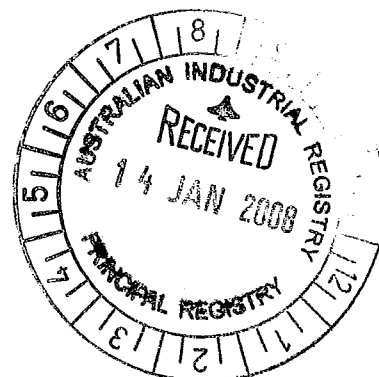

I am the President of the Northern Territory Police Association Inc and the Police Federation of Australia Northern Territory Police Branch, organisations registered under the Workplace Relations Act 1996, and am authorised to make this statement.

1. The following information in respect of an election is being lodged in accordance with s. 189(1) of the Workplace Relation Act 1996:

(a) an election is required in respect of the following offices:

(b) the reason for the election being:

(c) the electorate for this election is the financial members of the Northern Territory Police Association Inc and members of the Police Federation of Australia Northern Territory Police Branch.

(d) the voting system to be used in this election is the Direct Voting System.

(e) the date and time of the commencement and expiration of the period for nomination is as follows:

Nominations open	3 March 2008
Nominations close	31 March 2008

Further, as of the 31st December 2007, the NT Branch of the Police Federation of Australia had 1199 members, as per my declaration of the 8th of January 2008 pursuant to Section 233(1) of Schedule 1B to the Workplace Relations Act 1996 (Cwth), and as such our branch is entitled to two delegates to the Federal Council.

Rule 52 DO (14) provides for the "Election of Branch Delegates to Council". Pursuant to that rule the President is one delegate to council. An election is required pursuant to Rule 52DO at the conclusion of the Branch elections for one Branch Delegate to Federal Council.

The electorate for this election is the duly elected executive of the branch.
