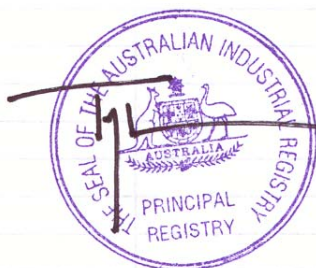

### **NT Branch PFA Executive Elections 2009**

I, **Vincent Michael Kelly** state as follows:

I am the President of the Police Federation of Australia Northern Territory Police Branch and the Northern Territory Police Association Inc, organisations registered under the Workplace Relations Act 1996, and am authorised to make this statement.

1. The following information in respect of an election is being lodged in accordance with s. 189(1) of the ROA Schedule (Schedule 1) to the *Workplace Relations Act 1996* and Reg. 138 of the Workplace relations (Registration and Accountability of Organisations) Regulations 2003:

(a) an election is required in respect of the following offices:

(b) the reason for the election being:

(f) the electoral roll of members will close at midnight 23 February 2009, being seven (7) days before the calling of nominations in accordance with clause 52DO(10)(b)(iv)(D) of Part CD – Northern Territory Police Branch of the Rules of the Police Federation of Australia; and  
(g) the voting system to be used in this election is the Direct Voting System.

Further, as of the 31 December 2008, the NT Branch of the Police Federation of Australia had 1275 members, as per my declaration of 7 January 2009 pursuant to Section 233(1) of the ROA Schedule (Schedule 1) to the *Workplace Relations Act 1996*, and as such our Branch is entitled to two delegates to the Federal Council.

Rule 52 DO (14) provides for the "Election of Branch Delegates to Council". Pursuant to that rule the President is one delegate to Council. An election is required pursuant to Rule 52DO at the conclusion of the Branch elections for one Branch Delegate to Federal Council.

The electorate for this election is the duly elected Executive of the Branch.

It is requested that you make arrangements with the Australian Electoral Commission for the above election in accordance with s.187 of the ROA Schedule (Schedule 1) to the *Workplace Relations Act 1996*.
