#### Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Registered Organisations Commission (the ROC) a declaration of results for the election of uncontested and contested offices for SA Branch [E2018/159]. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and on persons elected to office.

#### A notice must be published on the organisation's website

The organisation or branch must, as soon as practicable after receiving the post-election report, publish on its website a notice that a copy of the report is available from the organisation, branch or the AEC on request. The notice must be kept on the website for a period of at least 3 months (see regulation 141 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009).

#### Holders of office required to undertake approved training

Section 293K of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act) requires each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers undertake approved training within the required timeframe. Please also ensure that all new holders of office are advised of their obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests, the details of which are provided for in the RO Act.

#### Organisation must notify the Commission of changes

Also, section 233(2) of the RO Act requires that an organisation must notify the Commission within 35 days of any changes to the holders of office in the organisation. If there are no changes a notification is not required. If the election has resulted in any changes to the holders of office, the Police Federation of Australia-South Australia Police Branch must notify the Commission of these changes. In particular, please advise:

- 1. Person(s) who have ceased to hold office:
  - the name of the office vacated;
  - the date of the change of office holder; and
  - the name of the person vacating the office.
- 2. Person(s) who have commenced to hold office:
  - the name of the office now held;
  - the date of the change of office holder;
  - the name of the person now holding the office;

- the postal address of the person (generally the postal address of the organisation); and
- the occupation of the person now holding the office.

The notification must include a declaration by the Secretary (or other prescribed officer) that the information is a correct statement of the changes made. A template notification of changes, which may assist you, is attached. If any change does not apply until a date in the future, you do not need to notify until then (e.g. AGM, 1 January, 2nd Monday in March). If you have already lodged this information, please disregard this reminder.

Arrangement for conduct of election.

- [1] On 20 July and 4 September 2018, the South Australia Police Branch of the Police Federation of Australia lodged prescribed information and further correspondence regarding a scheduled election.
- [2] On 6 September 2018, I issued a decision to arrange for the conduct of that election and the decision was sent to the Branch on the same day.
- [3] On 27 September 2018, it became apparent that the Branch did not receive a copy of the election decision and the decision was immediately re-sent to the Branch. Subsequent to receiving the election decision, the Branch lodged amended prescribed information advising that on 13 September 2018, the Branch committee of management formed a new workgroup, the "Hindley Street Workgroup" and abolished two workgroups, the "Holden Hill Investigation Workgroup" and the "Sturt Investigation Workgroup".
- [4] On 3 October 2018, the Branch clarified that the Adelaide Workgroup's correct name is the Adelaide CBD Workgroup.
- [5] Accordingly, the decision issued by me as the Delegate of the Commissioner of the Registered Organisations Commission on 6 September 2018 is amended as follows:

In Attachment A of the decision, delete "Holden Hill Investigation Workgroup" and "Sturt Investigation Workgroup" and insert "Hindley Street Workgroup".

In Attachment A of the decision, amend the "Adelaide Workgroup" to "Adelaide CBD Workgroup".
