Irregularities

Details of written allegations of irregularities, and action taken by AEC:

Two items of written correspondence were received on 17th and 31st March 2021 in relation to members not receiving ballot papers, members receiving duplicate papers and members receiving envelopes with no ballot papers.

- The AEC investigated these allegations and concluded no irregularity had occurred and therefore no action was required.

Other Matters

Details: Section 44B (f)(xvii)(b) of the branch rules specifies that candidates are to provide their full names on the ballot paper. The organisation may wish to consider altering the rules to allow for candidates to provide a preferred name on the ballot paper. This would allow candidates to be represented on the ballot paper by the name they are known by other members.

Returning Officer actions required (Section 193):

- Rules regarding the timetable of the election were set aside as the AEC held concerns
 that the coronavirus pandemic may impact on the ability for stakeholders to fully
 participate in the election. A timetable for the conduct of the ballot which varied from the
 rules was set when the AEC was satisfied that stakeholders would be able to fully
 participate.
- Rules specifying the method of lodgement of nominations were set aside as the AEC held concerns that the coronavirus pandemic would impact on the ability for potential candidates to nominate. Instead nominations were received electronically, via email/the AEC's portal.

DECISION

Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 s.189—Arrangement for conduct of an election

Police Federation of Australia

(E2020/195)

Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 19 October 2020 the South Australia Police Branch (the Branch) of the Police Federation of Australia lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission (the Commission) prescribed information for seeking an election to fill the following offices for the next term of office:

President	(1)

Secretary	(1)
Ordinary Branch Committee Members	(8)

- [2] I note that on 17 February 2020, the Branch lodged prescribed information for an election (**E2020/47**) to fill a casual vacancy for the office of one of the Ordinary Branch Committee Members.
- [3] On 19 March 2020, I arranged for an election for that office in **E2020/47** (Decision [2020] ROCD 49). To date, election **E2020/47** has not been conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- [4] That office is now part of the prescribed information lodged by the Branch on 19 October 2020, as the remainder of the term of office will shortly expire.
- [5] There is therefore the potential for the two elections **E2020/47** (the casual vacancy) and **E2020/195** (a scheduled election for the new term of office) to occur simultaneously or in close temporal proximity to each other where the same office (one Ordinary Branch Committee Member) is required to be filled in both elections. The outcome of conducting both elections either simultaneously or close together would likely present difficulties for the Branch.

- [6] Staff of the Commission have also engaged with the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) about this matter and confirmed that there are mechanisms available for the AEC to further engage with the Branch to efficiently progress the matter.
- [7] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.
- [8] I am also issuing an amendment to my 19 March 2020 decision in **E2020/47** dealing with the casual vacancy, in order to prevent potential duplication of elections.
