Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 20 April 2021 the South Australia Police Branch of the Police Federation of Australia (**the organisation**) lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission prescribed information for an election to fill particular offices, due to insufficient nominations received in a previous election (**E2020/141**), as well as a casual vacancy, for the remainder of the term.

[2] The prescribed information lodged by the organisation referred to the number of each office required to be filled as “To be determined”.
