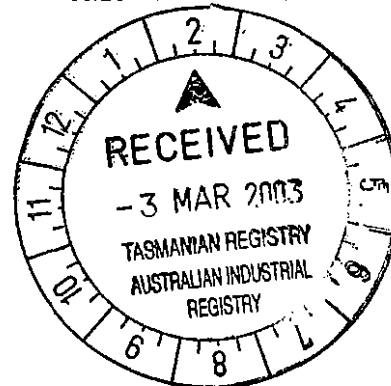

4. The Branch requests that the elections be held as soon as practicable. This Branch is prepared to assist by distributing



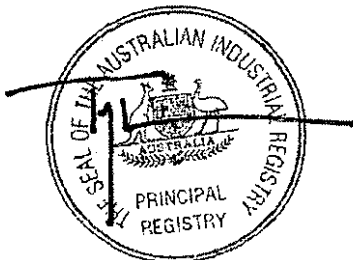
