I am an officer of the Tasmanian Branch of the Police Federation of Australia and am authorised to sign this statement, which is lodged in accordance with subsection 189 (1) of Schedule 1B – Registration and Accountability of Organisations, of the Act. I request that you arrange elections with regard to the following information:

1. Elections are required for the offices of Delegates for the following sub-branches:
 - Southern – 1 position of delegate only, and
 - Northern – 2 positions of delegate.
2. The reason for the elections is that the positions were not filled during the election process in late 2005.
3. The electorate for the elections relates to the sub-branches as specified in 1 above.
4. The date for nominations to close is specified as no later than 28th April 2006.
