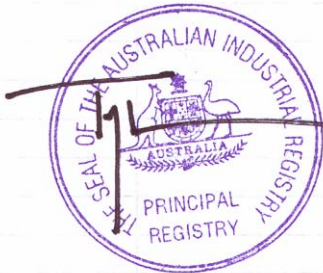
DECISION
