FAIR WORK (REGISTERED ORGANISATIONS) ACT 2009

PART 2 – CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS FOR OFFICE AND OTHER POSITIONS - SECTION 189 (1)

POLICE FEDERATION OF AUSTRALIA - WESTERN AUSTRALIA POLICE BRANCH

PRESCRIBED INFORMATION IN RESPECT OF AN ELECTION

I am an officer of the Police Federation of Australia - Western Australia Police Branch and am authorised by Rule 52AG, sub rule (4) and as Acting President as authorised by Rule 52AH, sub rule (1) to sign this statement which is lodged in accordance with the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 at Section 189 (1).

The Registered Rules of the Police Federation of Australia at Part CA - Western Australia Police Branch require:-

- 1. Rule 52AA (2) requires that the Executive shall be elected by and from the financial membership of the Branch, now numbering at the date of this statement, 5,736.
- 2. Rule 52AA (2) provides that the Branch Executive for which the elections are required shall comprise 15 offices as under:-
 - 11 positions for the Metropolitan Region
 - One position for the North (Kimberly/Pilbara) Region
 - One position for the Central (Midwest/Gascoyne) Region
 - One position for the East (Goldfields/Esperance) Region
 - One position for the South (Peel/Southwest/Wheatbelt/Great Southern) Region
- Rule 52AA Rule (9) directs that a "Region" shall be determined at Annual Conference and this occurred on June 24 2008 prior to the last elections conducted in 2009. There have been no subsequent determinations by Annual conference.
- 4. Rule 52AA(3) provides that the general election of Executive members shall be held every three years
- 5. Rule 52AA (3) provides that the Returning Officer should conduct the election so as to allow declaration of the result not later than the 15th of April, which for the current request will be 2012.

- 6. Rule 52AA (4), the sets down requirement for these elections which is the purpose for this request which arises from the impending normal course of events expiration of the term office of the current Executive Members who were elected in 2009, and who hold office until the dissolution of the 2012 Annual Conference, scheduled for June 25 26, 2012. At the dissolution of that Conference the Executive Elect will commence their office.
- 7. Rule 52AO sub rules (2) and (3) provide for the intervals between the actions required of the Returning Officer, commencing with the publishing of a notice that the Returning Officer is about to conduct the elections for positions on the Executive of the Police Federation of Australia Western Australia Police Branch.
- 8. Rule 52AA (2) (b) provides that within 10 working days of the election result being declared, the Executive Elect shall meet to elect from within itself, the following Branch Office Bearers prescribed in Rule 52AA (1).
- 9. Rules 52AF and 52AP further direct that the Federal Council Delegates also be elected, with the office of President being an ex officio Federal Council Delegate, and that the order in which the elections conducted on a "first past the post" basis, shall be: -

•	President (ex officio Federal Council Delegate)	1
•	Vice President	1
•	Deputy Vice President	1
•	Treasurer	1
•	Federal Council Delegates	2

- 10. Rule 52AO (3) provides for the Returning Officer's to determine the times and dates for nominations.
- 11. Rule 52AO(14) prescribes the Duties of the Returning Officer to determine the validity of votes and reject informal ballot papers; it provides for scrutiny, specifies that voting by proxy shall not be permitted and that the voting for an office shall be by a preferential ballot.
