Annual Return of Information for 2014 [AR2014/150]

I acknowledge receipt on 18 March 2014 of your Declaration providing information for the 2014 Annual Return of Information of Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees Association in accordance with subsection 233(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the Act).

I also acknowledge declarations relating to the branches of your organisation (see Table attached).

Further Information

1. Offices, Office Holders and Elections of the Organisation and its Branches

I note that the declaration by the national office only listed the national offices and national office holders. Also, it only reported elections related to the national offices. Under the Act, the declaration by the national office is required to provide information of the organisation and its branches. In this case, the declarations by the branches provide the information missing from the national return and so the information is deemed to be complete.

2. New South Wales Branch - 2013 Notifications of change of office holders

I acknowledge two notifications of change of office holders lodged by the New South Wales Branch on 27 March 2014 when it lodged the 2014 declaration. These notifications are required to be lodged within 35 days of a change occurring and the Branch acknowledged that one notification was well outside that time.


3. Organisation to lodge on behalf of all branches next year

Section 233 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* requires an organisation to lodge a declaration and copies of information with the Commission by the 31st March in each year. I note that in 2014 each branch of Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees Association lodged a declaration and the required information. As section 233 places the onus of lodgement on the organisation and not each branch, it is the view of the Commission that the national body of Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees Association is obliged to lodge all of the required information.

From 2015 the Commission intends to create one matter number for Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees Association, instead of a matter number for each branch of Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees Association. The national body of Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees Association will receive a reminder letter at the start of 2015. The branches will not receive a reminder letter.

From 2015 the national body of Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees Association is requested to collate and lodge the information regarding the national body of Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees Association and all of its branches. To assist with this task, I have attached a template annual return.




