Further to our telephone conversation on 12 April 2010 regarding the prescribed information for the election of the SDAEA Queensland branch (E2010/2555), I write to confirm that we varied in our understanding of the rules of the branch regarding the electorates for the district representatives to state council.

As discussed, in my view rule 15(e) of the branch rules provides that the electorates for the district representatives are all financial members of the branch. I understand that the branch is of the view that the electorates are the members of the relevant district.

I also confirm that we agreed that the branch would consider altering its rules so that they clearly state *from where* and *by whom* the representatives are elected. I trust that the branch will attend to this prior to any future elections for district representatives. Fair Work Australia is able to provide advice and comments on any draft alterations before they are effected.

Also, for future reference, prescribed information for elections is required to state the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed. Please ensure this is included on future statements of prescribed election information.
