

The voting to be employed would be direct voting system.


A Suggested time table for this could be Nominations;




**Notice and Statement of Prescribed Information for an Election<sup>1</sup>**

**Reasons for election:**

- Election for offices and positions marked A is required as the terms of office are due to expire in the normal course of events under the rules of the organisation
- Election for Trustee marked B is required to fill vacancies since Trustee is elected over a 2 year term . This organisation has 2 Trustee but only one trustee is elected every alternate year

**Elected by:**

- The electorate for the direct voting system is the whole of the Organisation (rule 11)

**Nominations open:**

- For offices to be elected by direct voting system - the first 42 days after approval

**Nominations close:**

For offices to be elected by direct voting system – 1st Feb in 2015 (rule 12)

**Cut off date for roll:**

- In all cases - 7 days prior to the opening date for nominations 10<sup>th</sup> March 2015)
