Dear Joe, as discussed with Mark Elliott the prescribed information lodged with the election contained clerical errors. In particular the prescribed information incorrectly makes reference to the office of Assistant Secretary although no such office exists under the rules. In addition, the prescribed information fails to refer to the office of Vice President notwithstanding an election for that office is due under the rules. Could the prescribed information be taken to be amended accordingly.

Also, the previously issued permit for Brad Gandy (RE2004/1193) which expired on 16 March 2007 was returned to Fair Work Australia on 3 July 2009.
