**Re: Election of Councillors and Office-Bearers of Timber Trade Industrial Association - Amended Application**

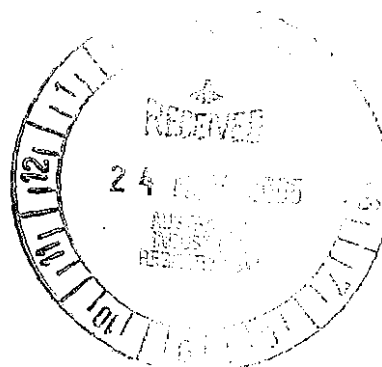

The reason for the election is that the terms of the above offices expire before the Annual General Meeting to be held in December 2005.




