**Section 233 - Obligation to lodge information with Fair Work Australia  
Annual Return of Information for year 2012 – AR 2012/263**

Furthermore, I note that regulation 149 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009* requires that Annual Returns be lodged by 31 March each year. Please ensure in future that this requirement is met.



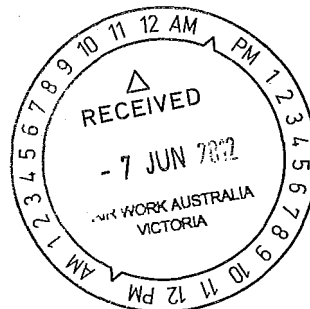


