#### **Re: s189 Prescribed Information for Election**

I write on behalf of the Transport Workers' Union of Australia regarding the casual vacancy which has occurred in the position of Federal Secretary as of the 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2006.

The union's rules now require that an appointment be made to that position for the remainder of the term and accordingly the union now seeks that an election be arranged to be held by the AEC for this position.
