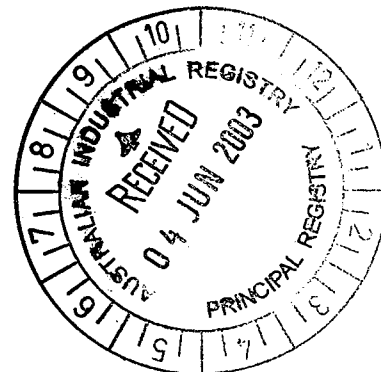



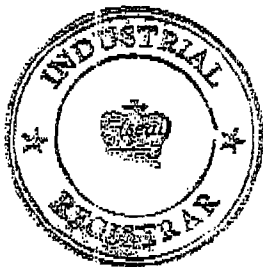

- 2.14 To affiliate to, federate with, amalgamate with, or otherwise combine with, any trade or industrial union or association of trade unions or any other organisation having objects similar in whole or in part to the objects of this Union; and to establish joint organisation and joint finances with other trade unions as a step towards amalgamation;
- 2.15 To act as bargaining agent, representative or agent or in a similar capacity to represent persons who may desire that the union represent them for industrial and related purposes, including but not limited to negotiating enterprise agreements, which the Committee of Management or the Administrative Committee or any Sub-branch Executive Committee agrees to so represent (and on such terms as are decided by those bodies) notwithstanding the fact that the persons concerned might not be eligible to join the union.
- 2.16 To make such arrangements or agreements with persons, firms, bodies or corporations whether situated in the State of New South Wales or elsewhere for the purchase of or supply to members of any goods or services which may be of benefit to the members of the Union either in part or whole and to act as buying agent in any such arrangements or agreements;
- 2.17 To invest and deal with the moneys of the Union not immediately required in such manner as may from time to time be determined;
- 2.18 To act as an industrial organisation of employees;
- 2.19 To act as an association of contract carriers;
- 2.20 To act as an association of contract drivers;
- 2.21 To do all such acts and things as are incidental to the achievement of the above objects.

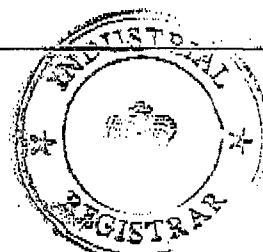
3 RULES TO BE ABIDED BY

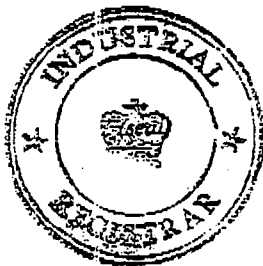

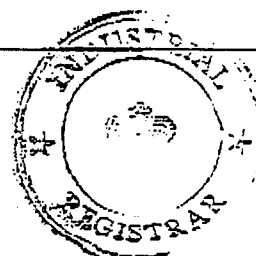
- 2.14 To affiliate to, federate with, amalgamate with, or otherwise combine with, any trade or industrial union or association of trade unions or any other organisation having objects similar in whole or in part to the objects of this Union; and to establish joint organisation and joint finances with other trade unions as a step towards amalgamation;
- 2.15 To act as bargaining agent, representative or agent or in a similar capacity to represent persons who may desire that the union represent them for industrial and related purposes, including but not limited to negotiating enterprise agreements, which the Committee of Management or the Administrative Committee or any Sub-branch Executive Committee agrees to so represent (and on such terms as are decided by those bodies) notwithstanding the fact that the persons concerned might not be eligible to join the union.
- 2.16 To make such arrangements or agreements with persons, firms, bodies or corporations whether situated in the State of New South Wales or elsewhere for the purchase of or supply to members of any goods or services which may be of benefit to the members of the Union either in part or whole and to act as buying agent in any such arrangements or agreements;
- 2.17 To invest and deal with the moneys of the Union not immediately required in such manner as may from time to time be determined;
- 2.18 To act as an industrial organisation of employees;
- 2.19 To act as an association of contract carriers;
- 2.20 To act as an association of contract drivers;
- 2.21 To do all such acts and things as are incidental to the achievement of the above objects.

3 RULES TO BE ABIDED BY

Any member who acts contrary to the objects of the Union, as set out in rule 2, shall be deemed to have failed to abide by rules of the Union.

4 REGISTERED OFFICE

The registered office of the Union shall be at 28 Anglo Road, Campsie, New South Wales, or at such a place as may be determined by the Committee of Management. Notwithstanding these rules, no change in the registered office of the Union shall be effective until notice is given to the Industrial Registrar in accordance with Section 224 of the Industrial Relations Act 1996 or any act replacing it.
