Re: Financial Report for year ended 31 December 2009 (FR2009/10268) Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the Act)

Thank you for the financial report of the South Australian/Northern Territory Branch of the Transport Workers' Union of Australia for the year ended 31 December 2009. The documents were lodged with Fair Work Australia on 6 April and 8 July 2010.

The Financial Report has now been filed.

Therefore, you do not need to take further action with respect to the report lodged. However, please act on the following when you prepare your next Financial Report:

### **Auditor's Report**

It appears that the auditor did not take into account the Committee of Management Statement in the auditing of the General Purpose Financial Report. Section 253(2)(c) of the Act states that the General Purpose Financial Report must consist of "any other reports or statements required by the reporting guidelines". Item 24 of the Reporting Guidelines requires a Committee of Management Statement to be prepared. The Committee of Management Statement must be prepared and signed as part of the General Purpose Financial Report before being given to the auditor. This ensures the statement is considered by the auditor and subsequently stated in the Auditor's Report as having been audited.

Please forward a copy of this letter to your auditor.

#### General Purpose Financial Report (GPFR)

Section 253(2) of the Act requires the reporting unit to provide information required by the Reporting Guidelines. Item 11 of the Reporting Guidelines lists the expenses required to be disclosed in the notes to, or on the face of, a financial statement. Such categories of expense that must be separately disclosed are:

- Employment benefits paid to office holders
- Employment benefits paid to employees (other than office holders)
- Fees and/or allowances paid for attendance at conferences
- Conference and meeting expenses

Two of the items stated in your Statement of Financial Performance include "Employee Responses" and "Federal Council Expenses." As previously requested, if these are employment benefits paid to employees and office holders respectively, please clearly identify and separate the two items into "Employment Benefits - office holders" and "Employment Benefits - employees."

Two other items are "Away from home expenses" and Travelling & Accommodation." If the expenditure in these figures relate to fees and/or allowances paid for attendance at conferences or to conferences and meeting expenses, please disclose them separately in the above categories when you next prepare the Financial Report.

### Report on recovery of wages activity

I note the accounts did not provide any information in relation to the recovery of wages activity. The reporting of recovery of wages activity is specified in items 16 to 23 and item 25(f) of the Reporting Guidelines and is generally referred to in the Committee of Management Statement. Where the reporting unit has not undertaken any recovery of wages activity for the financial year, a statement by a member of the Committee of Management to the effect that there was no recovery of wages activity for the financial year is sufficient.

### **Number of reporting units (Committee of Management Statement)**

In paragraph (e)(iv) of your Committee of Management Statement, you have stated that "the organisation consists of only one reporting unit." This is incorrect. Section 242 of the Act defines a reporting unit as "the whole of the organisation or a part of an organisation." Subsection (3) of the Act states that "where an organisation is divided into branches, each branch will be a reporting unit unless a certificate issued by the General Manager stating that the organisation is, for the purpose of compliance with this Part, divided into reporting units on an alternative basis is in force."

Accordingly, each branch of your organisation would constitute a separate reporting unit. As there are five branches and one federal body, the organisation is therefore made up of six reporting units. Please amend the statement in your next Financial Report to reflect this fact.

You also need to declare in the Committee of Management Statement whether the financial records of the Branch have been kept, as far as practicable, in a consistent manner to each of the other reporting units of the organisation (item 25(iv) of Reporting Guidelines).

### **Designated Officer's Certificate**

In your Certificate of Secretary, you stated "that the full report will be provided to members in the next edition of the Branch Journal;" Please include the date of publication of the Branch Journal containing the full report when you next lodge your Financial Report. Section 265(5)(b) of the Act requires you to provide the full report to members within 5 months from the end of the financial year. In relation to the Financial Report ended 31 December 2009, the Branch Journal must be published by the end of May 2010 in order to comply with the legislation.

### Reference to new Legislation

The Auditor's Report referred to "Part 3 of Chapter 8 of Schedule 1B of the Workplace Relations Act 1996." Please refer to the new legislation, that is, Part 3 Chapter 8 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009.

Operating Report for the year 2009 ended 31 December 2009

### **Principle Activities**

The principal activities of the Association during the reporting period were to provide industrial and organising services to the members consistent with the objects of the Association and particularly the object of protecting and improving the interest of the members.

The Associations' principal activities resulted in maintaining and improving the wages and conditions of employment of the membership, particularly for those members in collective enterprise agreements negotiated by the Association.

There were no significant changes in the nature of the Association's principal activities during the reporting period.

### Manner of resignation

Members may resign from the Association in accordance with rule 11, which reads as follows:

- 11. Resignation from membership
- (1) A Member may resign from Membership by notice in writing addressed and delivered to the Branch Secretary of the Branch in which the Member is enrolled.
- (2) A notice of resignation from Membership takes effect;
  - (a) if the Member has ceased to be Eligible:
    - (i) on the day on which the notice is received by the Union;
    - (ii) on the day specified in the notice;
  - (b) in any other case:
    - (i) at the end of 2 weeks after the notice is received by the Branch Secretary; or
    - (ii) on the day specified in the notice;

whichever is later.





- (3) Any Duties payable but not paid by a former Member, in relation to a period before the Member's resignation from the Union took effect, may be sued for and recovered in accordance with rule 81 as a debt due to the Union.
- (4) A notice delivered in accordance with sub-rule (1) is deemed to have been received by the Union when it was delivered.
- (5) A notice of resignation that has been received by the Union is not invalid only because it was not addressed and delivered in accordance with sub-rule (1).
- (6) A resignation from Membership is valid, even if it is not effected in accordance with this rule, if the Member is informed in writing by the Union that the resignation has been accepted.



### INDEPENDENT AUDIT REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF THE TRANSPORT WORKERS' UNION OF AUSTRALIA SOUTH AUSTRALIAN/NORTHERN TERRITORY BRANCH

### SCOPE

We have audited the Accounts being the Statement of Financial Position for the Year Ended 31st December 2009 and the Statement of Financial Performance as at 31st December 2009 and notes to and forming part of the Accounts of The Transport Workers Union of Australia, South Australian/Northern Territory Branch, for the year ended 31st December 2009.

The Committee of Management are responsible for the preparation and presentation of the accounts and the information they contain.

We have conducted an independent audit of these accounts in order to express an opinion on them to the Members of the Branch.

Our audit has been conducted in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards to provide reasonable assurance as to whether the accounts are free from material misstatements. Our procedures included examination on a test basis, of evidence supporting the amounts and other disclosures in the Accounts, and the evaluation of accounting policies and significant accounting estimates. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion as to whether, in all material respects the accounts are presented fairly in accordance with Australian Accounting Concepts and Standards and statutory requirements so as to present a view of the Branch which is consistent with our understanding of its financial position and the results of its operations.

In common with organisations of this type, it is not practical to establish adequate records or controls over cash receipts prior to their receipt and entry in the accounting records. Accordingly, our audit of cash receipts was limited to the amount recorded in the accounting records of the Union.

In our opinion, as far as it appears from our testing and examination, monies recorded as receipts have been properly brought to account by the Union.

The audit opinion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.

- 1) There were kept by the Branch in respect of the year, satisfactory accounting records detailing the sources and nature of the income of the Branch (including Income from Members) and the nature and purposes of Expenditure.
- 2) The attached General Purpose Financial Report is presented fairly in accordance with applicable Australian Accounting Standards and the requirements imposed by Part 3 of Chapter 8 of Schedule 1B of the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

### NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST DECEMBER 2009

#### NOTE 1: ACCOUNTING METHODS

In accordance with generally accepted accounting principals for organisations, membership contributions are accounted for on a cash receipts basis.

Otherwise, the accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Accounting Standards jointly issued by the Australian Professional Accounting Bodies. In particular -

- (a) The accounts have not been adjusted to record either changes in the general purchasing power of the dollar or in the prices of specific assets.
- (b) Depreciation of fixed assets is calculated on the reducing balance basis in order to write the assets off over their useful lives. Additions are depreciated from the date of purchase at the rates applicable to the asset.
- (c) Provisions for employee benefits in the form of Long Service Leave and Accrued Annual Leave have been made for the estimated accrued entitlements of all employees on the basis of their terms of employment.
- (d) No provision for income tax is necessary as "Trade Unions" are exempt from income tax under Section 23(f) of the Income Tax Assessment Act. Fringe Benefits Tax has been paid by the Union in accordance with the provisions of the Fringe Benefits Tax Assessment Act.

#### NOTE 2a: INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS

In accordance with Section 272 of the RAO schedule the attention of members is required to be drawn to subsections 272(1), (2) and (3) which read as follows

- (1) A member of a reporting unit, or a Registrar, may apply to the reporting unit for specified prescribed information in relation to the reporting unit to be made available to the person making the application.
- (2) The application must be in writing and must specify the period within which, and the manner in which, the information is to be made available The period must not be less than 14 days after the application is given to the reporting unit.
- (3) A reporting unit must comply with an application made under subsection (1).

    - (ii) on the day specified in the notice;

whichever is later.





- (3) Any Duties payable but not paid by a former Member, in relation to a period before the Member's resignation from the Union took effect, may be sued for and recovered in accordance with rule 81 as a debt due to the Union.
- (4) A notice delivered in accordance with sub-rule (1) is deemed to have been received by the Union when it was delivered.
- (5) A notice of resignation that has been received by the Union is not invalid only because it was not addressed and delivered in accordance with sub-rule (1).
- (6) A resignation from Membership is valid, even if it is not effected in accordance with this rule, if the Member is informed in writing by the Union that the resignation has been accepted.
