\*\*\*In accordance with Subrule 70(4), there shall be one (1) Branch Organiser elected from the members employed in each Rescue and Firefighting Unit.

# **B – REASON FOR ELECTION**

The last ordinary elections for all branches and the national union were held in 2003.

Subrule 70(1) provides that Presidents, Vice-Presidents, Secretaries, Assistant Secretaries where such positions exist, Trustees where such positions exist, and members of Branch Committee of Management shall be elected every three years.

Subrule 70(4) provides that Aviation Branch Organisers shall hold office for three years.

The term of office of all of the offices listed in A above expire as of 31 March 2006.

# D – COMPOSITION OF ELECTORATE

1. New South Wales Branch

- 1.1 The electorate for the positions of *Branch President*, *Branch Vice President*, *Branch Junior Vice President*, and *Branch Secretary* consists of all financial members the New South Wales Branch at the time when nominations for the election close **[Subrule 70(3)(a), Schedule 1, Subrule 1(b)]**
- 1.2 The electorate for the positions of *Branch Committee of Management Committee Persons* consists of all members the New South Wales Branch [Schedule 1, Subrule 1(f)]

### 2. Victorian Branch

- 2.1 The electorate for the positions of Branch President, Branch Vice President, Branch Junior Vice President, Branch Secretary and Branch Trustees consists of all financial members of the Branch at the time when nominations for the elections close [Subrule 70(3)(a)]
- 2.2 The electorate for the positions of *Branch Committee of Management MFESB Officer Committee Persons* consists of members who are MFESB Officers [Schedule 2, Subrule (1)(a)(ii)]
- 2.3 The electorate for the positions of *Branch Committee of Management MFESB Firefighter Committee Persons* consists of members who are MFESB Firefighters [Schedule 2, Subrule (1)(b)]
- 2.4 The electorate for the position of *Branch Committee of Management CFA Officer Committee Person* consists of members who are CFA Officers [Schedule 2, Subrule (1)(c)]
- 2.5 The electorate for the position of *Branch Committee of Management CFA Firefighter Committee Person* consists of members who are CFA Firefighters [Schedule 2, Subrule (1)(c)]
- 2.6 The electorate for the position of *Branch Committee of Management non-MFESB and Non-CFA Committee Person* consists of members who are non-MFESB and Non-CFA employees who are employed by another organisation and that is eligible for membership under the rules [Schedule 2, Subrule (1)(c)]

## 3. Queensland Branch

- 3.1 The electorate for the positions of *Branch President*, *Branch Vice President*, *Branch Junior Vice President*, *Branch Secretary*, *Branch Assistant Secretary* and *Branch Trustees* consists of all financial members of the Branch at the time when nominations for the elections close [Subrule 70(3)(a)]
- 3.2 The electorate for the positions of *Branch Committee of Management Officer* Delegates and Branch Committee of Management Firefighter Delegates consists of all financial members (whether that member is an Officer or a Firefighter) in the region for which an election is required. **[Schedule 3 Subrule (c)]**

#### 4. South Australian Branch

- 4.1 The electorate for the positions of Branch President, Branch Vice Presidents, Branch Secretary, Branch Assistant Secretary and Branch Trustees consists of all financial members of the Branch at the time when nominations for the elections close [Subrule 70(3)(a)]
- 4.2 The electorate for the positions of *Branch Ordinary Committee of Management Members* consists of all members of the Branch [Schedule 4, Subrule 1(c)]

#### 5. West Australian Branch

- 5.1 The electorate for the positions of Branch President, Branch Vice Presidents, Branch Secretary, Branch Assistant Secretary and Branch Trustees consists of all financial members of the Branch at the time when nominations for the elections close [Subrule 70(3)(a)]
- 5.2 The electorate for the positions of *Branch Ordinary Committee of Management Members* consists of all members of the Branch.

#### 6. Tasmanian Branch

6.1 The electorate for the positions of Branch President, Branch Vice President, Branch Junior Vice President, Branch Secretary and Branch Trustees consists of all financial members of the Branch at the time when nominations for the elections close [Subrule 70(3)(a)]

#### 7. Australian Capital Territory Branch

7.1 The electorate for the positions of Branch President, Branch Vice President, Branch Junior Vice President, Branch Secretary and Branch Trustees consists of all financial members of the Branch at the time when nominations for the elections close [Subrule 70(3)(a), Schedule 7 Subrule 1(b)]. This includes members of the branch employed by Serco Fire Services at Nowra and Jervis Bay and who are members of the ACT Branch by agreement between the NSW Branch and ACT Branch pursuant to Rule 53 (as certified on 19 January 2006).

#### 8. Aviation Branch

- 8.1 The electorate for the positions of *Branch President* and *Branch Secretary* consists of all financial members of the Branch at the time when nominations for the elections close [Subrule 70(3)(b)(i)]
- 8.2 The electorate for each Branch Committee of Management Member consists of the members of the State or Territory which the Branch Committee of Management Member is elected from and represents [Subrule 56(2)]

- 8.3 The electorate for the positions of Branch Vice Presidents consists of the Branch Committee of Management [Subrule 56(2)]
- 8.4 The electorate for each position of *Branch Organiser* consists of all members of the Branch employed in the Rescue and Firefighting Unit which that Branch Organiser represents and who are financial at the time when nominations for the elections close.

# E – CLOSING OF ROLLS AND DATE AND TIME OF COMMENCEMENT AND EXPIRATION OF NOMINATION PERIOD

- There is no provision in the rules of the organisation as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed. It is proposed that the date for the closing of the roll be a date on or after 1 March to be determined by the Australian Electoral Commission returning officer after consultation with each Branch. This is in accordance with past custom and practice.
- 2. Rule 27(10 provides that:
  - (10) In a Branch election -
    - (a) date for the opening of nominations shall be the first weekday occurring on or after 14<sup>th</sup> March;
    - (b) the time on which nominations close shall be 5pm on the first weekday occurring on or after 31<sup>st</sup> March;
    - (c) the time on which nominations may no longer be withdrawn shall be the first weekday occurring on or after 11<sup>th</sup> April;
    - (d) the date for the posting of bailot papers shall be 21st April;
    - (e) the time on which the ballot closes shall be 5pm on 7th May.
- Rule 74(2) provides that a Branch Returning Officer shall call for nominations by notice, which shall be displayed in the registered office of a Branch and at work areas and be published in the Union journal and in other ways likely to come to the attention of the members of the Branch.
- 4. Rule 74 (1) provides that nominations for Branch positions must be delivered to the Branch Returning Officer or to the Registered office of the Branch addressed to the Branch Returning Officer by 31 March in each year in which there is a general election for these positions.

#### F - VOTING SYSTEM TO BE EMPLOYED

- 1. The election in respect of the positions of *Aviation Branch Vice Presidents* is conducted by a collegiate voting system.
- 2. The election of all other positions listed in Part A above is conducted by a direct voting system.

#### PART 2 – NATIONAL OFFICES

#### A - OFFICES FOR WHICH AN ELECTION IS REQUIRED

An election is required for the Offices of National President and National Secretary in accordance with Rules 12 and 23.

#### **B – REASON FOR ELECTION**

In accordance with subrule 23(1), the National President and National Secretary shall be elected every third National Committee of Management Annual Meeting. This meeting is due to be held in November with final dates to be advised when confirmed.

#### **C – NUMBER OF OFFICES**

Refer to A above

#### **D – COMPOSITION OF ELECTORATE**

The electorate for the positions of *National President* and *National Secretary* consists of the National Officers and the National Delegates to the National Committee of Management. [Subrule 23(1)]

# E – DATE AND TIME OF COMMENCEMENT AND EXPIRATION OF NOMINATION PERIOD

- 1. In accordance with Subrule 23(2), the nomination period is required to commence no less that two full months immediately prior to the scheduled commencement date of the National Committee of Management Election Meeting by Notification to the National Secretary, all National Committee of Management Members and all Branch Officers.
- 2. Refer to B above regarding the notification of dates.

#### F - VOTING SYSTEM TO BE EMPLOYED

The elections for the positions of National President and National Secretary are conducted by a collegiate voting system.
