My declaration of the uncontested positions is attached.


The elections are now complete.



LODGING OF PRESCRIBED INFORMATION IN RESPECT OF SECTION 214 AND REGULATION 61 IN RELATION TO ELECTIONS OF THE UNITED FIREFIGHTERS UNION OF AUSTRALIA.

The rules referred to in this document are the registered rules of the United Firefighters Union of Australia.

PART 1: BRANCH OFFICES

- 1 An election is required for the following office:
 - In the Australian Capital Territory Branch, pursuant to Australian Capital Territory Branch RULE 1: One (1) Vice-President One (1) Secretary
- 2. The election is required for the reason that subsequent to the election process (E No. 3031 of 2000 referred) the Secretary and Vice-President have resigned leaving these two positions vacant.
- 3. The voting system to be employed in elections for Branch Offices is a direct voting system.
- 4. The electorates for Branch Offices are as follows:
 - 4.1 In the case of the Australian Capital Territory Branch, members of the Australian Capital Territory Branch shall, pursuant to Australian Capital Territory Branch Rule 7 be eligible to nominate and vote for Australian Capital Territory Branch Offices.
