The elections are now complete.

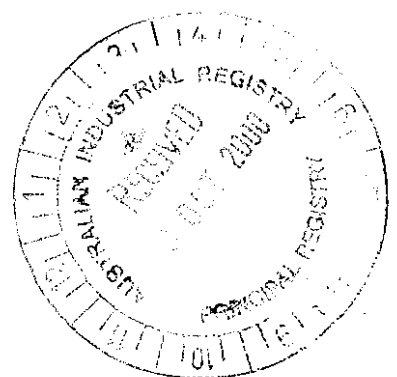

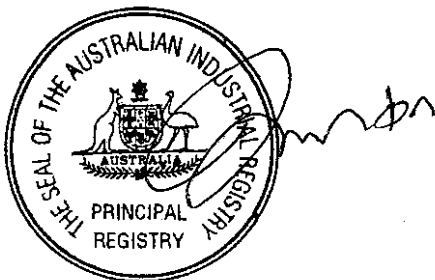

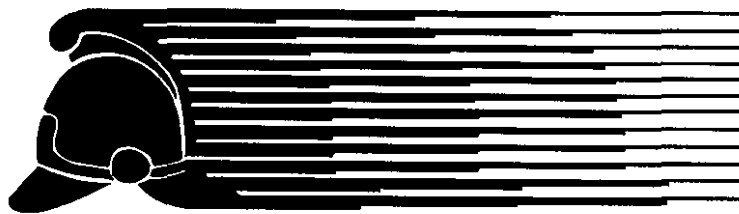

As such, we are requesting that nominations to these positions as detailed in the prescribed information again be called, and if necessary, a ballot be conducted.

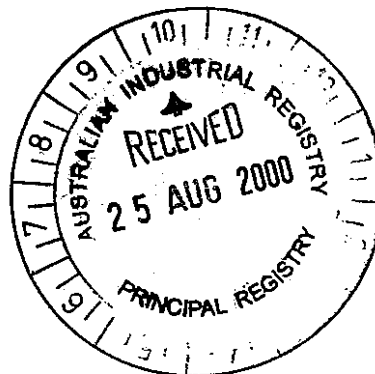

IN RELATION TO ELECTIONS OF THE UNITED FIREFIGHTERS UNION OF AUSTRALIA.

The rules referred to in this document are the registered rules of the **United Firefighters Union of Australia**.

PART 1: BRANCH OFFICES

- 1 An election is required for the following office:
 - 1.1 In the Australian Capital Territory Branch, pursuant to Australian Capital Territory Branch **RULE 1:**
 - One (1) Vice-President
 - One (1) Secretary
2. The election is required for the reason that subsequent to the election process (E No. 3031 of 2000 referred) the Secretary and Vice-President have resigned leaving these two positions vacant.
3. The voting system to be employed in elections for Branch Offices is a direct voting system.
4. The electorates for Branch Offices are as follows:
 - 4.1 In the case of the Australian Capital Territory Branch, members of the Australian Capital Territory Branch shall, pursuant to Australian Capital Territory Branch Rule 7 be eligible to nominate and vote for Australian Capital Territory Branch Offices.
