

Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 – (RO Act) Financial report for year ended 30 June 2011 – FR2011/2615

I acknowledge receipt of the full financial report and a concise report for the Queensland Branch of the United Firefighters' Union of Australia (UFUA) for year ended 30 June 2011. The reports were lodged with Fair Work Australia on 4 November 2011.

The full report and the concise report have not been filed.

The issues arising from this year's financial report appear to be identical to the issues that were raised in my letter addressed to you dated 11 November 2011 (see attached) regarding the financial report for year ended 30 June 2010 [FR2010/2601]. The letter stated that the financial report for 2010 had been filed but required that the matters raised be rectified in future financial reports. It appears that no such steps have been taken for the 2011 financial report.

In order for this financial report to be filed, further information is required from the reporting unit (Queensland Branch of the UFUA).

Please provide a written response to the following questions by 21 November:

- 1. Was a <u>resolution passed</u> by the committee of management pursuant to s.265(2) of the RO Act to allow a concise report to be provided to members? This resolution must have been passed <u>before</u> the concise report was provided to members on 30 September 2011. If a resolution was passed, please provide this office with the details of when the committee of management passed such a resolution.
- If there was no <u>s.265(2) resolution passed</u> or the resolution was passed after 30 September 2011, the reporting unit should immediately replace the concise report with the general purpose financial report on the UFUA, Queensland Branch website as the <u>concise report should not be provided to members</u>. The members should be notified that the reports were substituted. The auditor's report and the operating report must nevertheless appear on the website as these documents form part of the full report.
 - If such a resolution was not passed please advise this office whether the above steps have been taken to substitute the concise report for the general purpose financial report.
- 3. The operating report disclosed that there are 5 full-time and 2 part-time employees for the reporting unit, however the statement of income and expenditure do not show any entries

in regards to wages or salaries to employees who are office holders and employees other than office holders.

Please confirm whether the employees are actually employees of the Queensland Branch of the federally registered UFUA, or employees of the State Association - United Firefighters' Union of Australia, Union of Employees, Queensland. If the employees are from the latter association, the operating report should state that the reporting unit has 0 employees, and accordingly, no benefits to employees will have to appear in the statement of income and expenditure and no provisions will be required in the statement of financial position. However, if the employees are employed by the reporting unit the wages/salaries to those 7 employees and any provisions for their leave entitlements must be disclosed and details of these figures must be provided.



1 SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

This general purpose financial report has been prepared in accordance with Accounting Standards, Australian Accounting Interpretations and The Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009.

The accounts are prepared on an accrual basis and are based on historical costs. Accounting policies have been consistently applied unless otherwise stated.

(a) Income Tax

The association is exempt from income tax under section 50 - 15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997. The ongoing applicability of this ruling is at the discretion of the Australian Taxation Office.

(b) Cash

For the purpose of the statement of cash flows, cash includes deposits at call which are readily convertible to cash on hand and are used in the cash management function on a day to day basis, net of outstanding bank overdrafts.

(e) Goods and Services Tax

Business expenses and assets are recognized net of the amount of GST except where the amount of GST accrued is not recoverable from the Australian Taxation Office.

2. INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OR REGISTRAR

In accordance with the requirements of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of Section 272 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, which read as follows:

- (1) A member of a reporting unit, or the General Manager of Fair Work Australia, may apply to the reporting unit for specified prescribed information in relation to the reporting unit to be made available to the person making the application..
- (2) The application must be in writing and must specify the period within which and the manner in which the information is to be made available. The period must be not less than 14 days after the application is given to the reporting unit.
- (3) A reporting unit must comply with an application made under subsection (1).

1 INFORMATION ON THE CONCISE FINANCIAL REPORT
