I write to request authorisation from your Office under section 189 of Schedule 1B of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 for the Australian Electoral Commission to conduct an election for the vacant Branch Committee of Management position of WAFB Firefighter Ordinary Committee Member.

The vacancy was caused by the incumbent of this position being elected as Branch President in the recently conducted by-election.

The Branch Committee of Management has instructed me to make this request for arrangements to be made for the Australian Electoral Commission conduct an election in accordance with our rules after receiving four expressions of interest for the vacant position. Due to the strong interest in the position the Branch Committee of Management has resolved to conduct an election rather than appointing an eligible person under UFUA Rule 71—By Elections.

- (e) Rule 72 (3) of the union's rules requires the Committee of Management or the Branch Executive to determine dates for calling nominations, the closing of nominations and the dates for opening and closing of the ballot. However we would assume the AEC Returning Officer conducting the byelection will liase with the Branch for these determinations to be made.
- (f) The AEC Returning Officer will advise the Branch the appropriate date for closing the role of voters.
- (g) A direct voting system is to be used to conduct the election.
