Re: UFUA - WA Branch Election - E2006/217

I have received your fax of 3 October 2006 providing further information regarding vacancies for the following offices:

WAFB Officer Vice President
WAFB Firefighter Ordinary Committee Member

Your fax indicates that these positions are vacant due to their respective incumbents (Messrs Jolly & Gamble) being elected to higher offices in 2006.

However your fax does not refer to particular provisions of the UFUA that expressly provide that the above positions become vacant when their incumbents are elected to a higher office.

WA Branch Rule 9 provides that if a person has nominated for more than 1 position in an election, and is elected to a position in that election, then their nomination(s) for any lower position(s) in that election will lapse. However it would appear that that circumstance is not identical to the present situation where persons have been elected to higher positions in a *later election*. In such circumstance it is not immediately apparent, under the UFUA Rules, that the persons would automatically vacate their lower offices.

To ensure that the election can proceed on the firm basis that the above positions are unambiguously vacant the best option may be for the two persons to resign (if that is their wish) from their respective earlier offices. A copy of the two resignation letters should then be forwarded to the Registry. Thereafter the Registry will determine the matter ASAP.


