





- (10) a declaration signed by you or other prescribed officer that the preceding copies of information being lodged are correct statements of the information contained in the organisation's records

Regulation 149 of the Workplace Relations (Registration and Accountability of Organisations) Regulations 2003 requires this information to have been lodged by **31 March 2008**.

You should note that failure to comply with this obligation is subject to a civil penalty provision under section 305 of the RAO Schedule.
