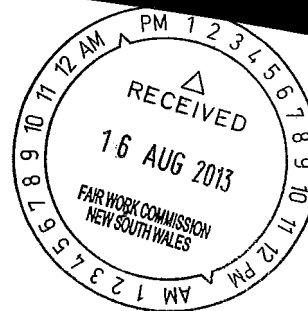

P O'Donnell then went on to become an Organiser and then a Team Lead with us at United Voice. He is calm, well organised and always thinking strategically. I am confident that Pat will do a fantastic job in this role.

It was moved C Smith, seconded K Prescott Brown - "That due to Carolyn Smith's appointment as Branch Secretary and therefore resignation as Assistant Secretary, Pat O'Donnell be appointed by Branch Council for the position of Assistant Secretary, which is being filled as a casual vacancy by way of a secret ballot."

P O'Donnell: This is an important role and I have big shoes to fill. There has been a lot of change in the branch. It is certainly a role that you can't do successfully without a good team behind you. Everyone has been fantastic. Thank you to all the people I have been working with for making the transition easier. Thank you for endorsing me today. I look forward to seeing the Union grow and to getting get results for our members.

## **SECRETARY'S REPORT:**

### **Child Care**

The funding we received for 40% of the Child Care sector has allowed us to have positive conversations with Child Care workers about why to get on board and stay on board as the funding is only for 2 years and only available to centers with a Union registered agreement. We have grown by over 400 members in Child Care in only a couple of weeks. We are often having internal conversations about how to get younger members so it's great that the majority of these new members are young women. Through our conversations these members are now able to link politics with their life and work outcomes.

### **Health**

After finalising bargaining we are now in the day to day task of ensuring that the agreement is kept and honoured. Although Shenton Park and Swan Districts Hospitals' are closing down in April next year, members have still not been given any information and no consultation process has been established by DOH. We were in the commission today over this matter. We want monthly meetings and may have to take industrial action to make it happen.

The EN bargaining agreement expires in October.

RN bargaining continues.

## **Education**

The agreement has been finalised and we are now ensuring that the agreement happens. One of the issues is yard duty and ensuring that EA's are not supervising children on their own. It was a good outcome as we got the inductions back however instead of centralised inductions we are doing inductions all over the place. This is intentional in order to drain the resources of the Union. We are in discussions about how to make this a realistic process.

Former Official, Sue Ellery, is now the Shadow Minister for Education and has raised an issue in Parliament about the safety of school cleaners. They should be working in pairs and have access to communication devices.

## **Aged Care**

Bargaining is a never ending cycle in Aged Care. We are currently bargaining at Aegis and beginning at Hall and Prior.

## **Crown Casino**

Crown have offered 9.25% over 3 years and are claiming poverty however we know that they have deeper pockets than they are making out especially with all of the new construction going on. They said it was their final offer but they will be moving on that. The agreement expires in July.

## **MSS**

Things are moving and a ballot was conducted on Monday which voted yes to industrial action. We are at 3.2% but still quite behind other states. Why should we accept less in the west? Delegates are committed to getting a good outcome.

## **Disabilities**

The Activ agreement was signed recently. They have a new HR Manager and a 180 degree turnaround was had with how Activ deal with industrial relations matters. A whole list of issues was suddenly resolved very easily and quickly.

## **Oxfam**

The Secretary gave an overview of the Oxfam campaign which deals with the issues of basic unfairness and food aid programs. They are asking Unions to sign onto their pledge. It is not money support but public support they are after. An example of their campaign is that they asked the world's top 10 food producers to look at their production lines and fairness of wages amongst other things. It worked.

It was moved C Smith, seconded P Hitt - "That United Voice signs onto the Oxfam Campaign and gives their public support."

List of Office holders	A list of the names, postal addresses and occupations of the persons holding the offices (note the definition of <b>office</b> and <b>officer</b> in ss.6 and 9) [s.230(1)(c)]
List of Branches	A record of the name of each branch of the organisation [s.230(1)(d) and r.147(a)]
New Branches	A record of the name of each branch that commenced operation in the previous 12 months [s.230(1)(d) and r.147(b)]
Old Branches	A record of the name of each branch that ceased operation in the previous 12 months [s.230(1)(d) and r.147(c)]
Addresses of Organisation and Branches	A record of the address of the office of the organisation and the address of the office of each branch [s.230(1)(d) and r.147(d)]
Elections in Organisation and Branches	A record of each election that must, under the rules of the organisation, be held during the year commencing 1 January of the year in which the return is lodged, for any offices in the organisation and branches of the organisation . Statement concerning number of members	A record of the number of members on 31 December in the previous year; and If the organisation has entered into an agreement relating to members of State unions under s.151(1) of the RO Act,- a record of the number of members of the organisation who were (on 31 December in the previous year) ineligible State members in relation to the organisation within the meaning of s.150 of the RO Act. ### Obligation to notify of changes within 35 days

If there are any changes during the year to the list of offices, list of officeholders, list of branches (where relevant) and the address of the organisation and/or its branches an organisation must, within 35 days of the change, lodge with The Commission, a notification of such changes certified by declaration signed by the secretary or other prescribed officer of the organisation to be a correct statement of the changes made [RO Act s.233(2) and RO Regulations r.151 refer].
