

### RE: APPLICATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 210 OF THE WORKPLACE RELATIONS ACT 1996

On 13<sup>th</sup> December 2001 I lodged a request for an election to be conducted for Offices in the New South Wales, Victorian, Australian Capital Territory, Tasmanian, South Australian, West Australian, Northern Territory and Queensland Branches of the LHMU pursuant to Section 210 of the Workplace Relations Act. I noted that in the case of delegates to Branch Council representing sections and/or divisions the numbers were to be advised. Rule 53 provides that Branch Sections to be elected at the 2002 elections shall be determined by the National Executive based on the financial membership of each branch as at 1 December 2001. The National Executive has now endorsed those sections and delegate numbers in a postal ballot. It has also endorsed the consolidated application which is attached.

On 7 January 2002 Stephen Kellett sought clarification of a number of aspects of the 13 December application. Subsequently we discussed these issues by telephone. The attached application deals with the issues which were raised in that letter with the exception of the question that relates to the numbers of Divisional Executives in New South Wales. These were endorsed by the New South Wales Branch Executive in 1998 based on the size and character of the membership of the divisions in accordance with Rule 75N11(a)(ii).

For completeness I have set out below the prescribed information which is set out in Regulation 61 for the purposes of Section 214(1) of the Act as follows:

- 1. The names of the offices in respect of which an election is required are set out in the attachment hereto.
- 2. The reason for the election is that the terms of the offices has expired.
- 3. The numbers of the offices in respect of which an election is required are set out in the attachment. Numbers of Delegates to Branch Council representing Sections or Divisions have been endorsed by the National Executive in accordance with Rule 53.

4. The electorate for the attached positions are the members of the relevant branch unless specified below. However the electorate for sectional representatives to Branch Council in the case of branches other than New South Wales is the members of the relevant Section.

In the case of the New South Wales Branch the electorates for positions, other than those specified below are all the members of the New South Wales Branch. The positions which are an exception to this are the following:

Branch Executive Vice President / President Liquor and Hospitality Division - to be elected by the members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

Branch Executive Vice President - to be elected by the members of the branch other than Liquor and Hospitality Division members.

Assistant Branch Secretary (1) - to be elected by members of the branch other than members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

Assistant Branch Secretary / Secretary Liquor and Hospitality Division - to be elected by members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

Assistant Branch Secretary / Assistant Secretary Liquor and Hospitality Division - to be elected by members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

Members of the Branch Executive are to be elected by and from their respect Divisions. Delegates to the Branch Council are to be elected by and from their respective Divisions. Delegates to National Council are to be elected by and from their respective Divisions.

- 5. The date and time of the commencement and expiration of the period during which nomination of candidates will be called are dealt with in Rule 40 and 41.
- 6. The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election is a direct voting system.

It is intended to lodge a separate application for elections by and from the National Council for the National Executive and National Officers in 2002. The rules provide that this election take place on 3 August 2002 or the next business day after 3 August in that year.

The above information is lodged in accordance with Section 214(1) of the Workplace Relations Act and I trust that it fulfils the requirements thereof.

I refer to your letter dated 13 December 2001 requesting an election under subsection 214(2) of the Workplace Relations Act 1996. I note that the numbers of Delegates to Branch Council representing Sections or Divisions will be advised later. However I was not sure of the basis for some of the details and I seek your advice and clarification regarding the following:

- how the numbers of Divisional Executive Members for the Leisure and Tourism, Manufacturing and Community and Property Services Divisions (5, 5 and 10 respectively) were arrived at given that Rule N11(a)(ii) provides simply that they will be determined by the "size and character" of the Divisions?
- why there were only 2 Branch Assistant Secretaries and only 10 Branch Executive Members listed for the Queensland Branch when Rule 75D Q4 provides for 3 and 11 respectively?
- why the prescribed information lodged indicated that the numbers of Zone representatives for the Victorian Branch AEAV Committee of Management representatives will be advised when the rules certified on 20 December 2001 set out that there shall be 2 representatives and a regional Staff Representative for each Zone?
- why the prescribed information lodged indicated that the members of the branch other than members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division constitute the electorate for two Assistant Branch Secretaries when Rule N5(b)(iv) appears to provide that only one of the three "shall be elected by the membership other than Liquor and Hospitality Division members"?



#### RE: APPLICATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 210 OF THE WORKPLACE RELATIONS ACT 1996

In accordance with the resolution of the National Executive of the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union I request that an election be conducted for offices in the Australian Capital Territory, New South Wales, Northern Territory, Queensland, South Australian, Tasmania, Victorian and Western Australian Branches of the LHMU pursuant to Section 210 of the Workplace Relations Act.

The prescribed information which is set out in Regulation 61 for the purposes of Section 214(1) of the Act is as follows:

- 1. The names of the offices in respect of which an election is required are set out in the attachment hereto.
- The reason for the election is that the terms of the offices has expired.
- 3. The numbers of the offices in respect of which an election is required are set out in the attachment. However, you will note that in the case of delegates to Branch Council representing Sections and / or Divisions the numbers are to be advised. Rule 53 provides that the Branch Sections to be elected in the 2002 elections shall be determined by the National Executive based on the financial membership of each branch as at 1 December 2001. - 4. The electorate for the attached positions are the members of the relevant branch unless specified below. However the electorate for sectional representatives to Branch Council in the case of branches other than New South Wales is the members of the relevant Section.

In the case of the New South Wales Branch the electorates for positions, other than those specified below are all the members of the New South Wales Branch. The positions which are an exception to this are the following:

Branch Executive Vice President / President Liquor and Hospitality Division - to be elected by the members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

Branch Executive Vice President - to be elected by the members of the branch other than Liquor and Hospitality Division members.

Assistant Branch Secretary (2) - to be elected by members of the branch other than members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

Assistant Branch Secretary / Secretary Liquor and Hospitality Division - to be elected by Liquor and Hospitality Division members.

Assistant Branch Secretary / Assistant Secretary Liquor and Hospitality Division - to be elected by members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

Members of the Branch Executive are to be elected by and from their respect Divisions. Delegates to the Branch Council are to be elected by and from their respective Divisions. Delegates to National Council are to be elected by and from their respective Divisions.

- 5. The date and time of the commencement and expiration of the period during which nomination of candidates will be called are dealt with in Rule 40 and 41.
- 6. The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election is a direct voting system.

It is intended to lodge a separate application for elections by and from the National Council for the National Executive and National Officers in 2002. The rules provide that this election take place on 3 August 2002 or the next business day after 3 August in that year.

The above information is lodged in accordance with Section 214(1) of the Workplace Relations Act and I trust that it fulfils the requirements thereof.
