

Dear Ms Buchanan

I request that an election be conducted for the office of Member of the National Executive for the Western Australian Branch of the LHMU pursuant to Section 210 of the Workplace Relations Act, 1996.

The prescribed information which is set out in Regulation 61 for the purposes of Section 214(1) of the Act is as follows:

- a. The names and numbers of the officers in respect of which an election is required are:
 - National Executive member- Western Australian Branch (1)
- b. The reason for the election is the resignation of the incumbent. A copy of her resignation letter is attached.
- c. The electorate for this position consists of members of the National Council of the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union. Rule 22 sub-rule (g) provides that in the event of an extraordinary vacancy in the office of any member of the National Executive an election by and from the National Council may take place by way of a secret postal ballot of the members of the National Council, rather than at a meeting of National Council, in the event that the National Executive decides that the election may be conducted by way of postal ballot. The National Executive, in a postal ballot which closed on 25 January 2002, decided that the election may be conducted by way of a postal ballot of National Council.
- d. Candidates for election as a member of the National Executive must be delegates to the National Council and comply with the other provisions of Rule 22.
- e. The date and time of the commencement and expiration of the period during which nomination of candidates will be called is dealt with in Rule 22 of the LHMU Rules.
- f. The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election is a collegiate voting system.

The above information is lodged in accordance with Section 214(1) of the Workplace Relations Act and I trust it fulfils the requirements thereof. Please contact me if you have any queries.
