

RE: APPLICATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 182 OF SCHEDULE 1 OF THE WORKPLACE RELATIONS ACT 1996 - NATIONAL EXECUTIVE ELECTION

In accordance with the resolution of the National Executive of the LHMU of 24 May 2006 I request an election be conducted for members of the National Executive of the LHMU pursuant to Section 182 of Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

The prescribed information which is set out in Regulation 138 (1) for the purposes of Section 189 of Schedule 1 of the Act is as follows:

 The names of the officers in respect of which an election is required are set out in the attachment hereto.

The reason for the election is that the terms of the national offices will expire on 3 August 2006.

- 2. The number of the offices with respect to which an election is required is set out in the attachment. It should be noted that there are affirmative action requirements with respect to the positions of National Vice President and the members of the Executive from the New South Wales, Queensland, South Australian, Victorian and Western Australian Branches. There is also a provision in Rule 20(c)(vii) that additional female affirmative action delegates be elected if necessary in order to ensure a minimum requirement for women members of the National Executive of 50%. The number of additional female affirmative action delegates, if any, to be elected will therefore not be able to be determined until the elections for other positions have taken place in the order as set out in Rule 22(f)(i)
- 3. The electorate for the attached positions are delegates to National Council as elected at the 2006 Branch Quadrennial elections. These delegates take office from 3 July 2006.

- 4. Candidates for election as a members of the National Executive must be delegates to the National Council and comply with the other provisions of Rule 22.
- 5. The date and time of the commencement and expiration of the period during which nomination of candidates will be called is dealt with in Rule 22 of the LHMU Rules.
- 6. The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election is a collegiate voting system.

Rule 19(aa) provides that following the conclusion of the branch quadrennial elections, delegates to National Council shall assemble on 3 August (or the next business day after 3 August) whereupon the first item of business shall be the election of the National Officers and the National Executive. As 3 August 2006 is a Thursday and upon advice having been received about holding over the term for a few days,and for the sake of practical meeting dates of a 5 day National Executive/Council, the proposal is for the National Council meeting to commence on Tuesday 8 August 2006 and the election to take place at the commencement of that meeting The venue is the Novotel St Kilda, 16 The Esplanade, St Kilda, Victoria.

The above information is lodged in accordance with Section 189 of Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 and I trust it fulfils the requirements thereof. Please contact me if you have any queries.
