RE: APPLICATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 182 OF THE WORKPLACE RELATIONS ACT 1996

In accordance with the resolution of the National Executive of the Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Union I request that an election be conducted for offices in the Australian Capital Territory, New South Wales, Northern Territory, Queensland, South Australian, Tasmania, Victorian and Western Australian Branches of the LHMU pursuant to Section 182 of the Workplace Relations Act.

The prescribed information which is set out in Regulation 138 for the purposes of Section 189(1) of the Act is as follows:

1. The names of the offices in respect of which an election is required are set out in the attachment hereto.
2. The reason for the election is that the terms of the offices have expired or that one or more new offices has been created.
3. The numbers of the offices in respect of which an election is required are set out in the attachment. Rule 53 provides that the Branch Sections to be elected in the 2006 elections shall be determined by the National Executive based on the financial membership of each branch as at 1 December 2005. A postal/facsimile ballot of the National Executive took place on 25th – 30th January 2006 which endorsed the attached application.
4. The electorate for the attached positions are the members of the relevant branch unless specified below. However the electorate for sectional representatives to Branch Council in the case of branches other than New South Wales is the members of the relevant Section.

In the case of the New South Wales Branch the electorates for positions, other than those specified below are all the members of the New South Wales Branch. The positions which are an exception to this are the following:

Branch Executive Vice President / President Liquor and Hospitality Division - to be elected by the members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

Branch Executive Vice President - to be elected by the members of the branch other than Liquor and Hospitality Division members.

Branch Assistant Secretary - to be elected by members of the branch other than members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

Branch Assistant Secretary / Secretary Liquor and Hospitality Division - to be elected by Liquor and Hospitality Division members.

Branch Assistant Secretary / Assistant Secretary Liquor and Hospitality Division - to be elected by members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

Members of the Branch Executive are to be elected by and from their respective Divisions.
Delegates to the Branch Council are to be elected by and from their respective Divisions.
Delegates to National Council are to be elected by and from their respective Divisions.


5. The date and time of the commencement and expiration of the period during which nomination of candidates will be called are dealt with in Rule 40 and 41.
6. The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election is a direct voting system.

It is intended to lodge a separate application for elections by and from the National Council for the National Executive and National Officers in 2006. The rules provide that this election take place on 3 August 2006 or the next business day after 3 August in that year or such other time as decided by the National Council, National Executive or National Secretary. In 2006 the National Council meeting will commence on Tuesday 8 August in Melbourne.

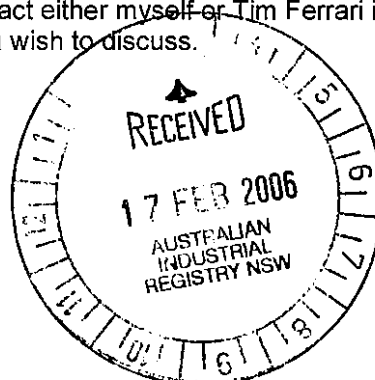

I write further to my letter of 17th February 2006 and to our telephone conversation yesterday afternoon.

I confirm the following variations to the name and number of officers in respect of which the election is required:

1. ACT Branch

- (a) The proposed Branch Council Sections for Accommodation and Casinos are to be included in the General Hospitality Section.
- (b) The proposed Baking and Sales Section is to be included in the Miscellaneous (General) Section.

2. NSW Branch

The correct numbers of financial members in the Manufacturing Division is 2,940 and in the Liquor and Hospitality Division 11,226 giving 5 and 9 Branch Council delegates respectively.

3. Northern Territory Branch

It is noted that the Northern Territory Branch has a separate rule governing the Branch Council section numbers which has application.

4. Queensland Branch

The proposed Retail Stores Section and the Visually Impaired Section shall be included in the proposed General Section.

5. South Australian Branch

The correct number of delegates in the South Australian Branch in the Child Care Section is 2. This number was included in the application but not reflected in the accompanying schedule of membership numbers. In respect of the Hotels and Clubs (non residential) Section the correct number of delegates should be 4.

6. Tasmanian Branch



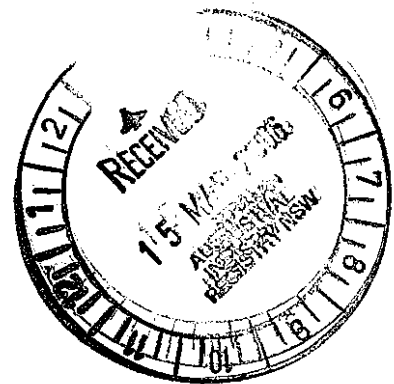

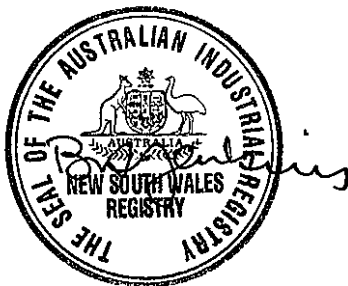
AMENDING DECISION
