

RE: APPLICATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 182 OF SCHEDULE 1 OF THE WORKPLACE RELATIONS ACT 1996 – NATIONAL EXECUTIVE ELECTION

In accordance with the resolution of the National Executive of the LHMU of Wednesday 20th June I request an election be conducted for National Secretary of the LHMU pursuant to Section 182 of Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

The next scheduled meeting of the National Council commences at 9am on Tuesday 14th August. The venue for the meeting is the Unions NSW Trades Hall Auditorium, Goulburn Street, Sydney. It is hoped that the election can take place at the commencement of the meeting on 14th August.
