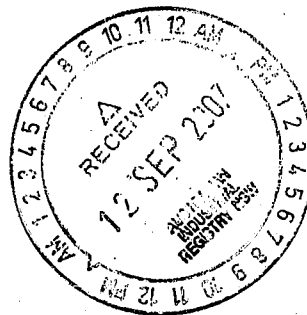

Reason for Election:

The reasons for the election is the resignation of one incumbent who has been elected as National Secretary and the filling of a new additional position of Assistant National Secretary, arising from correspondence to the Registry (dated 10 September 2007) by the National Secretary advising of rule alterations in Rule 20 and Rule 22 of the rules of the organisation. A decision in that matter has not however been issued as yet. As far as is possible, the filling of such vacancies by election simultaneously is the preferred approach of the Union.

Elected by:

1. The electorate for these positions are delegates to National Council.
2. The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election is a collegiate voting system.

Nominations:

The date and time of the commencement and expiration of the period during which nomination of candidates will be called is dealt with in Rule 22 of the LHMU Rules.
