If a website is not available, publishing a notice in a journal or newsletter would be considered appropriate.

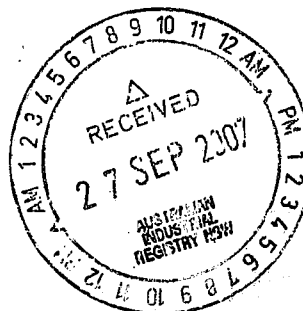
