# APPLICATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 182 OF THE FAIR WORK (REGISTERED ORGANISATIONS) ACT 2009

In accordance with the resolution of the National Executive of the Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Union I request that an election be conducted for offices in the Australian Capital Territory, New South Wales, Northern Territory, Queensland, South Australian, Tasmania, Victorian and Western Australian Branches of the LHMU pursuant to Section 182 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009.
