The Fair Work Commission is making arrangements, under subsections 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, with the Electoral Commissioner for the conduct of the subject election by a member of staff of the Australian Electoral Commission, who will contact you in the near future about the election.

The Delegate of the General Manager is satisfied that the prescribed information provided is sufficient to grant the election in this matter. However, rule 53(c)(ii) of the organisation's rulebook provides that "no Branch Section may consist of fewer than 25 members". In order to avoid ambiguity concerning the election of Delegates to Branch Council from NT Sections in future, I would recommend that United Voice consider altering the rules to include a specific provision to clarify the minimum number of members required for Branch Sections of the Northern Territory Branch.

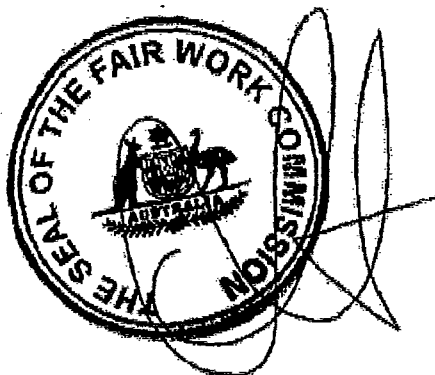

**RE: ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE CONDUCT OF AN ELECTION (E2014/64)**

This letter addresses the issues raised in your correspondence in the above matter dated 17 February 2014.

Delegate to Branch Council – Northern Territory Branch – Hospitality (Including Contractors) – Alice Springs and Yulara

The prescribed information does indeed indicate that there are 15 members in this Section. In addition, Rule 53(c)iii does note that no Branch Section may consist of fewer than 25 members, in the case of Branches with fewer than 5,000 members. However, in the case of the Northern Territory Branch, the provisions of Rule 75C also apply.

Rule 75C (NT5a) states that:

*“(a) The Branch shall have a Branch Council consisting of all members of the Branch Executive and delegates elected by the members on the following basis:*

*Delegates elected from each Section in the proportion of one delegate for every 150 members or part thereof provided that no Section shall be allowed more than three delegates.”*

In previous years, the interpretation of this rule by both the union and the Fair Work Commission has been that “or part thereof” indicates that Sections of the Northern Territory are able to consist of fewer than 25 members. I note that in 2010, the then Fair Work Australia approved an application to run an election for United Voice whilst the Section in question also consisted of 15 members. I have attached as Appendix A to this letter a copy of the United Voice prescribed information from January 2010 and as Appendix B a copy of the FWA decision to hold the 2010 Branch Elections. I have highlighted the above information within Appendix A (page 10 of this letter).

**Arrangements for the conduct of an Election (E2014/64)**

I refer to the prescribed information dated 31 January 2014, and the amended prescribed information dated 11 February 2014, which was lodged on 31 January and 11 February 2014 respectively. The prescribed information is in relation to the conduct of a scheduled election for offices to various Branches of United Voice.

After analysis of the requested offices and the requirements of the rules, I have noted the following.

- Delegate to Branch Council - Northern Territory Branch - Hospitality (Including Contractors) - Alice Springs & Yulara

The prescribed information provides that there are 15 members in this Section. Rule 53(c)(ii) provides that no Branch Section may consist of fewer than 25 members, in the case of Branches with fewer than 5,000 members. For this reason, could you please provide further amended prescribed information which excludes the Delegate to Branch Council from the "Hospitality (Including Contractors) - Alice Springs & Yulara" Section of the Northern Territory Branch.

- Delegates to National Council - from QLD; SA; VIC and WA

The prescribed information lists more than three Delegates to National Council from the QLD; SA; VIC and WA Branches. However, rule 18(b) provides that from the 2014 elections, the number of delegates from branches to National Council will be determined by the following formula:

"A quota will be ascertained by dividing the income of the union by a divisor of 97. The number of delegates to which each branch is entitled will be determined by dividing the income of the Branch by the quota, and if on such divisor there is a remainder greater than one half of the quota, the Branch will be entitled to one more delegate. Notwithstanding anything in this rule, each branch will be entitled to a minimum of three delegates."


Rule 18(c) provides:

"For the purposes of this rule the income of the union means the income collected by the Branches of the union resulting from the payment of the basic contribution rate as referred to in Rule 15(a) during the previous financial year. This income is inclusive of any commission paid to an employer or to a union delegate collected by the branch during the previous financial year".

In order to calculate the number of Delegates to National Council that are required from each of the above-mentioned Branches, could you please provide details of the "income of the union" as set out in rule 18(c). Could you also provide details of the income of the QLD; SA; VIC and WA Branches, within the further amended prescribed information.

**AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 189(1) OF THE FAIR WORK (REGISTERED ORGANISATIONS) ACT 2009**

I wrote to you on 31 January 2014 to lodge prescribed information concerning forthcoming elections and request that an election be conducted for offices in the Australian Capital Territory, New South Wales, Northern Territory, Queensland, South Australian, Tasmania, Victorian and Western Australian Branches of United Voice.

After submitting this application, it has come to our attention that it is necessary to amend our application in two minor areas. Accordingly, I am writing to you today to notify the Fair Work Commission formally of these two amendments and ask that our application with the amendments be approved.

The two amendments to our application are detailed below. I have also attached at Appendix A an updated list of offices for election and have highlighted in that list where the changes have occurred.

1. South Australian Branch Section entitled 'SA Water'  
A clerical error meant that in the original application, the incorrect number of members was assigned to the above Section. I can confirm that 122 members should be assigned to this section as per the revised information given in Appendix A. There is no alteration to the number of delegates to Branch Council from this Section due to this change.
2. South Australian Branch Section entitled 'Bridgestone (Salisbury)'  
Rule 53c(ii) of the United Voice rules state that "No Branch Section may consist of fewer than 50 members (or fewer than 25 members in the case of Branches with fewer than 5000 members)."

It has come to our attention that the South Australian Section entitled 'Bridgestone (Salisbury)' contains 10 members. Due to the presence of rule 53c(iii), the South Australian Branch Council has met and passed a resolution to merge the 'Bridgestone (Salisbury)' section with the 'Miscellaneous Private' section. The newly merged section will now contain 318 members in total and will be known as 'Miscellaneous Private'. This section will now comply with Rule 53c(iii) and will be entitled to 1 delegate to Branch Council.

The South Australian Branch Council meeting of February 10 confirmed these changes as per the process outlined in Rule 53b(ii) of the Rules of United Voice.

The effect of these changes is that the total number of delegates to the South Australian Branch Council will be reduced from 50 to 49.

Appendix A to this letter contains an updated list of offices for election incorporating the amendments outlined in (1) and (2) above.

In the case of the New South Wales Branch the electorates for positions, other than those specified below are all the members of the New South Wales Branch. The positions which are an exception to this are the following:

*Branch Executive Vice President / President Liquor and Hospitality Division* - to be elected by the members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

*Branch Vice President* - to be elected by members of the branch other than members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division

*2 Branch Assistant Secretaries* - to be elected by members of the branch other than members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

*Branch Assistant Secretary / Secretary Liquor and Hospitality Division* - to be elected by Liquor and Hospitality Division members.

*Branch Assistant Secretary / Assistant Secretary Liquor and Hospitality Division* - to be elected by members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

*Members of the Branch Executive* - to be elected by and from their respective Divisions.

*Delegates to the Branch Council* - to be elected by and from their respective Divisions.

*Delegates to National Council* - to be elected by and from their respective Divisions.

5. The date and time of the commencement and expiration of the period during which nomination of candidates will be called and the cut-off date for the roll of voters are dealt with in Rules 40 and 41 of the United Voice rules. Specifically:

*40(h): The returning officer must call for nominations for the offices by advertising in at least one metropolitan daily paper at least twenty-one days before the date for closing of nominations, which will be at a time or in a manner fixed by the returning officer and mentioned in the advertisement.*

*41(b)iii: Provided that the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed must be a day no earlier than 30 days and no later than 7 days before the day on which nominations for the election open.*

It is proposed that a specific timetable for the elections be developed in conjunction with the Australian Electoral Commission.

6. The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election is a direct voting system.

It is intended to lodge a separate application for elections by and from the National Council for the National Executive and National Officers in 2014. The rules provide that this election take place at the National Council meeting to be held on or prior to 3 September 2014.
