

Organisation must respond to the post-election report of the Australian Electoral Commission: E2017/259

On 5/07/2018 the Registered Organisations Commission (the ROC) received a post election report from the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) for election E2017/259 dated 4/07/2018. The AEC will have also provided the report to the organisation under section 197 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act).

The report identifies rules that were difficult to interpret or apply, in particular rules 40(g), 40(k) and 40(j)(ii). This letter serves as a reminder of the obligations imposed on the organisation or branch as a consequence of the AEC's report. If a response has already been sent to the AEC and made available to all members please disregard this letter.

A notice must be published on the organisation's website

The organisation or branch must publish on its website a notice that a copy of the report is available from the organisation, branch or the AEC on request. The notice must be kept on the website for a period of at least 3 months (see regs 141(4) and (5)).

A written response must be provided to the AEC

A written response must be provided to the AEC within 30 days of receipt of the report. The organisation's response must include whether the organisation or branch intends to take action and if so what action the organisation or branch intends to take (s198(2)).

Extract of report must be made available to members

The organisation or branch must make the section of the report relating to the difficult rules available to its members (s198(3)). This extract from the report must be made available to the members before or at the same time as the organisation's response is made available to members.

Written response must be made available to members

A copy of the organisation's response to the AEC must be made available to members either:

- within 30 days after the response is given to the AEC, or
- published in the next edition of the organisation or branch journal (s198(5))

Subsection 198(6) and regulation 142 prescribe ways in which the relevant extract and the copy of the response can be made available to members. These do not limit the ways in which they can be made available to members. The organisation will comply if it does all of the following:-

- publish the report extract and the copy of the response in the next edition of the organisation or branch's journal; and
- within 30 days of giving the response to the AEC:
 - lodges with the ROC a copy of the relevant extract and response, together with a declaration that a copy will be provided to any member who so requests; and
 - give notice in the next edition of the organisation or branch's journal, or an appropriate newspaper, that a copy of the relevant extract and response are available on request to each member free of charge; and
- publish the relevant extract on the website within 14 days after receiving the report, and publish the response on the website within 14 days of giving the response to the AEC (reg 142(2)).

Penalties may apply

If the organisation or branch does not:

- respond to the AEC within 30 days,
- make the extract of the report relating to the rules available to members no later than the organisation's response is made available to members, or
- make the organisation's response available to members within 30 days or in the next edition of the journal,

the organisation may face penalties under the RO Act. Each requirement listed above is a civil penalty provision that may result in fines for the organisation

As noted above, if the response and report have already been made available to members and the AEC, please disregard this letter. If you have any questions in relation to these obligations please contact the ROC for assistance by email to regorgs@roc.gov.au.

If the organisation or branch decides to alter its rules in response to the AEC's report

If the organisation or branch decides to alter its rules in response to the AEC's report, the ROC is NOT able to provide advice and assistance regarding draft alterations or the processes required to make the alterations. Rule alterations remain a function of the Fair Work Commission.

Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Registered Organisations Commission (the ROC) a declaration of results for the election of stage 1 uncontested offices for South Australia Branch and uncontested offices for Queensland, Northern Territory, New South Wales and Australian Capital Territory Branches [E2017/259]. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and on persons elected to office.

A notice must be published on the organisation's website

The organisation or branch must, as soon as practicable after receiving the post-election report, publish on its website a notice that a copy of the report is available from the organisation, branch or the AEC on request. The notice must be kept on the website for a period of at least 3 months (see regulation 141 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009).

Holders of office required to undertake approved training

Section 293K of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act) requires each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers undertake approved training within the required timeframe. Please also ensure that all new holders of office are advised of their obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests, the details of which are provided for in the RO Act.

Organisation must notify the Commission of changes

Also, section 233(2) of the RO Act requires that an organisation must notify the Commission **within 35 days of any changes** to the holders of office in the organisation. **If there are no changes a notification is not required.** If the election has resulted in **any changes** to the holders of office, the United Voice must notify the Commission of these changes. In particular, please advise:

1. Person(s) who have ceased to hold office:
 - the name of the office vacated;
 - the date of the change of office holder; and
 - the name of the person vacating the office.

2. Person(s) who have commenced to hold office:
- the name of the office now held;
 - the date of the change of office holder;
 - the name of the person now holding the office;
 - the postal address of the person (generally the postal address of the organisation); and
 - the occupation of the person now holding the office.

The notification must include a declaration by the Secretary (or other prescribed officer) that the information is a correct statement of the changes made. A template notification of changes, which may assist you, is attached. If any change does not apply until a date in the future, you do not need to notify until then (e.g. AGM, 1 January, 2nd Monday in March). If you have already lodged this information, please disregard this reminder.

Section 143(c) of the <i>Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009</i> states the defect period is not less than 7 days after candidates have been notified</p>



Following the decision, it came to our attention that it is necessary to amend the Application in one minor area.



Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 31 January 2018 United Voice ('the organisation') lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission prescribed information in relation to the conduct of an election.

[2] On 2 February 2018 the organisation lodged amended prescribed information with the Registered Organisations Commission reflective of an alteration to the organisation's rules, which was certified by the Fair Work Commission on 31 January 2018, identified by matter number (R2017/294).

[3] For the purposes of the conduct of this election, the organisation's rules, which determine particular matters relating to the prescribed information for this election, are to be read in accordance with, and subject to, the new transitional rule number 76, which became operative upon certification of the alteration to the rules.

[4] The alteration effects the following changes to the rules.

The Branch management and decision making functions, formerly held by the Branch Council, have been transferred to the Branch Executive. The Branch Council of each Branch has been transformed into an advisory body. Consequently, a Delegate to a Branch Council, will no longer hold an *office* as defined in section 9 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* but holds a *position* of Delegate to Branch Council.

For the purpose of electing zone representatives to the Ambulance Employees Australia Victoria, the number of zones has been reduced from thirteen to four based upon a change to the geographic and operational composition of the zones.

The New South Wales Branch is entitled to two fewer delegates to the National Council resulting from a change to the number of elected Divisional delegates from that Branch.

[5] I am satisfied that an election for the offices and positions set out in Attachment A is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

It is intended to lodge a separate application for elections by and from the National Council for the National Executive and National Officers in 2018. United Voice Rules provide that this election take place at the National Council meeting to be held on or prior to 3 September 2018. The date scheduled for this meeting is 27-29 August 2018.



PRESCRIBED INFORMATION PURSUANT TO REGULATION 138 OF THE FAIR WORK (REGISTERED ORGANISATIONS) REGULATIONS 2009

The prescribed information ("PI") required under Regulation 138 for the purposes of Section 189(1) of the Act is as follows:

1. The names of the offices in respect of which an election is required are set out in Appendix A. The details set out in the Appendix have been endorsed by the National Executive.
2. The reason for the election is that the terms of the offices have expired.
3. The numbers of the offices in respect of which an election is required are set out in Appendix A. Rule 53 provides that the number of delegates to Branch Councils to be elected by Branch Sections in the 2018 elections shall be endorsed by the National Executive based on their financial membership as at 1 December 2017. A ballot of the National Executive took place over 29 January – 30 January 2018 which endorsed the attached application.

Appendix A also contains the name of each Section and the number of financial members at 1 December 2017 together with the number of delegates to Branch Council for your information.

4. The electorate for the attached offices are the members of the relevant branch unless specified below. However, the electorate for sectional representatives to Branch Council in the case of branches other than New South Wales is the members of the relevant Section.

In the case of the New South Wales Branch the electorates for offices, other than those specified below are all the members of the New South Wales Branch. The offices which are an exception to this are the following:

Branch Executive Vice President/President Liquor and Hospitality Division - to be elected by the members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

Branch Vice President - to be elected by members of the branch other than members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division

1 Branch Assistant Secretary- to be elected by members of the branch other than members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

Branch Assistant Secretary / Secretary Liquor and Hospitality Division - to be elected by Liquor and Hospitality Division members.

Branch Assistant Secretary / Assistant Secretary Liquor and Hospitality Division - to be elected by members of the Liquor and Hospitality Division.

Members of the Branch Executive - to be elected by and from their respective Divisions.

Delegates to the Branch Council - to be elected by and from their respective Divisions.

Delegates to National Council - to be elected by and from their respective Divisions.

Divisional Committees of Management, including Divisional President/Vice President/Secretary/Assistant Secretary – to be elected by and from their respective Divisions.

5. The date and time of the commencement and expiration of the period during which nomination of candidates will be called and the cut-off date for the roll of voters are dealt with in Rules 40 and 41 of the United Voice rules. Specifically:

40(h): The returning officer must call for nominations for the offices by advertising in at least one metropolitan daily paper at least twenty-one days before the date for closing of nominations, which will be at a time or in a manner fixed by the returning officer and mentioned in the advertisement.

41(b)iii: Provided that the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed must be a day no earlier than 30 days and no later than 7 days before the day on which nominations for the election open.

It is proposed that a specific timetable for the elections be developed in conjunction with the Australian Electoral Commission.

6. The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election is a direct voting system.
