I refer to the above election for your organisation.

Section 197(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* ("the Act") requires the AEC to provide a written report on the conduct of the election to the Fair Work Commission and to the organisation or branch for whom the election was conducted. A copy of the report in relation to this election is attached.

Section 198 of the Act requires that if an organisation or branch is given a Post-Election Report under Section 197 that identifies a rule that was difficult to interpret or apply, the organisation or branch must, within 30 days, give a written response to the AEC on that aspect of the report. The response must specify whether the organisation or branch intends to take any action in relation to the rule, and if so, what action it intends to take.

If the attached report identifies a rule that was difficult to interpret or apply, you should forward your response to the AEC by email to 'industrial.elections@aec.gov.au' within thirty days of the date of the report.

Section 198 and the regulations also require an organisation to make the Post-Election Report and the organisation's response to the report (if applicable) available to members.

Further, Regulation 141(4) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009* requires an organisation or branch to publish a notice on its website advising members that a copy of the Post-Election Report is available upon request. If a website is not available, publishing a notice in a journal or newsletter would be considered appropriate.





UNION EXECUTIVE ELECTION(S) FEDERAL

I am the duly elected Secretary of the Western Australian Shire Councils, Municipal Road Boards, Health Boards, Parks, Cemeteries, Racecourse, Public Authorities and Water Boards Union, (the Union) having been declared elected for a four year term by the Returning Officer appointed by the Australian Electoral Commission in October 8th 2013.

As the duly Secretary, and as authorised by the executive committee of management (on the of September 2015) of the Federal Union I hereby make application for the conduct of an election **pursuant to Section 189(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009** to be held for the offices of Union President, Union Vice Presidents (4), Union Trustees (3) and Union Treasurer pursuant to the requirements of Rule 17 of the Union General Rules.

It will be noted from the Rules that the existing election process is carried out at the Annual General Meeting and does not provide for an express period for nominations to be lodged or for the closing of the roll. In the request for an election, the Union has nominated time frames that it considers reasonable having regard for the size of the electorate and the union's rules.

The details of the request are as set out below.

1. OFFICES FOR WHICH AN ELECTION IS TO BE CONDUCTED

Union President (1 year term)

Union Vice President (4 positions) (1 year term)

Union Treasurer (1 year term)

Union Trustees (3 positions) (1 year term)

2. REASON FOR THE ELECTION

The terms of the existing office holders will expire on the 14th of December 2015.

3. ELECTORATE

In respect of the offices of Union President, Union Vice President, Union Treasurer and Union Trustee the electorate shall mean all members of the Union Council elected in accordance with the Rules of the Division that they represent. This means in practice the WA Division as it is the only Division in the Union

4. NOMINATION PERIOD


Nominations for the said offices should be called for at the Annual General Meeting to be held pursuant to Rule 26 of the UNION GENERAL RULES PART 1, by the Returning Officer /Agent determined by the Fair Work Commission pursuant to the requirements of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009.

The Union's rules generally provide that the nominations for office(s) and the elections take place at and on the day(s) of the Union Annual General Meeting . The Annual General Meeting will be held **December 15 2015.**

5. TYPE OF VOTING SYSTEM

Collegiate

The union requests that in issuing the necessary orders for elections to be held that the current persons holding or acting in the Offices for which an election are to be held, continue until such time as the declaration of results is issued by the Australian Electoral Commission.
