- Rules specifying the method of lodgement of nominations were set aside as the AEC held concerns that the coronavirus pandemic would impact on the ability for potential candidates to nominate. Instead nominations were received electronically, via email or the AEC's portal.
- Nomination period for NRA Office Bearers was extended to two weeks and not seven _ days

Non-COVID applications of section 193:

The timeframe of 3 days from the date of declaration of results for the NRA Board and the nominations open for the NRA Office bearers was in-sufficient for the RO to plan for the election and was extended for the conduct of the ballot.

Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 23 December 2019 the National Retail Association Limited, Union of Employers lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices:

Board Member	(At least 3, no more than 9)		
Chairman	(1)		
Deputy Chairman	(1)		

[2] Rule 38 of the organisation's rules deals with elections for office and sets out dates for the calling of nominations and other events in the election process. That rule provides for elections in 'each alternate year' (i.e. every second year) starting from 2018. The previous election for this organisation, the only one since its registration under the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act* 2009 (the RO Act), occurred in 2018 (E2018/152).

[3] By contrast, other parts of the organisation's rules, particularly rule 20, which refer to the composition of the board, contain references to a term of office of three years.

[4] On 31 January 2020, following an inquiry from staff of the Registered Organisations Commission, the Association advised that it sought an election this year, in accordance with Rule 38.

[5] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the Act, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

[6] The rules of an organisation, including in relation to its officers, terms of office and elections, are of course matters for the organisation, subject to compliance with the RO Act. While I am satisfied that an election is required, I invite the organisation to take steps to amend its rules in order to address the internal inconsistency that is within its rules in relation to terms of office and elections. I also note that it is open to the AEC to make a report on election-related

rules and their application as part of its post-election report if the AEC considers it appropriate to do so.
